"Improvements in or relating to machines for processing tea leaf and like commodities".

Abstract—This invention relates to improvements in machines for processing tea leaf and like commodities.

According to the present invention, a machine for processing tea leaf and like commodities comprises co-operating processing surfaces provided by two relatively rotatable plates or discs having serrated, battened or like friction developing surfaces positioned face to face between which the leaf is processed, in combination with feed means for feeding the leaf to be processed into a localised feed area at the periphery of the said discs which extends over an arc of less than 90° of a disc periphery, so that the leaf is fed into the confined processing space between the two discs.

The processing action on the leaf takes place within a somewhat narrow band of surfaces on the co-operating faces of the discs which extends from the area of peripheral in-feed of the leaf in the general direction of and following the predominating component of the relative rotation between the two discs.

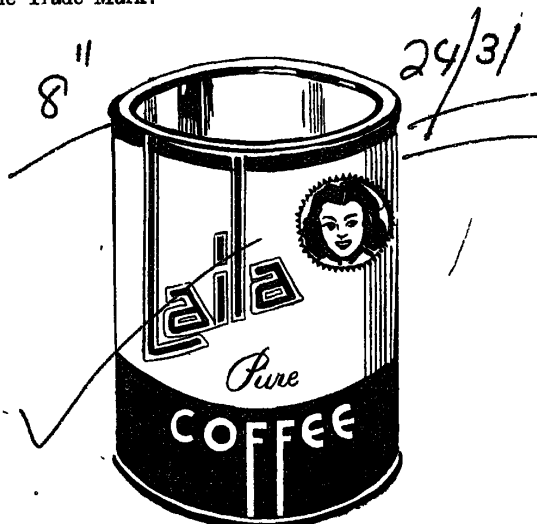
