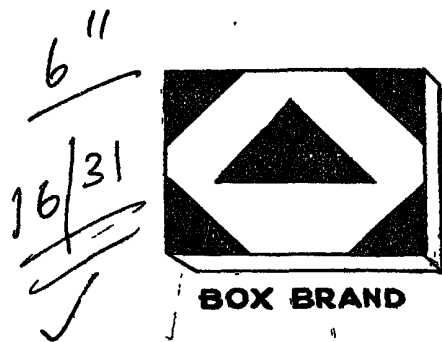

"Improvements in hand-operative knitting
machines"

Abstract—This invention relates to hand-operative
knitting machines. The nature of the invention can be
ascertained from claim 1 which reads as follows:—

1 In a hand-operative knitting machine of the kind
indicated, the combination comprising a needle-bed
embodying a row of reciprocal needles the stem or
shank portion of each needle having a butt for engage-
ment with the shuttle device to move the needles con-
secutively to a forward knitting position and consecu-
tively to a rearward knitting position alternately in
the forward and the return movement of the shuttle
device, needle-retaining means for engagement with
the butt of each needle temporarily to retain the
needles collectively in each said knitting position
alternately said means adopted to be actuated simul-
taneously with the engagement of the shuttle device
and the butt of each needle to allow such movement
of the needles, and a shuttle device having means for
engagement with the butt of each needle to move the
needles as defined.

Abstract—The nature of the invention can be ascer-
tained from claim 1 which reads as follows:—

1 In a hand-operative knitting machine of the kind
indicated, a needle-bed embodying a row of reciprocal
needles each needle being of a form consisting of an
upstanding hook portion at the outer or knitting-operative
end extending into a stem or shank which extends
into a downturned leg at the inner end of the needle,
the needle-bed being so constructed and the row of
needles so fitted thereto that the downturned leg of
each needle engages with the cam-face of the needle-
retracting bar or slat to retract the needles consecu-
tively to the rearward knitting position and the hook
portion of each needle is maintained upstanding

"Improvements relating to pipe couplings"

Abstract—This invention relates to pipe
couplings

An object of the present invention is to provide
a coupling in which a high compressive force can
be exerted on to the surface of the pipe without
risk of inward collapse or harmful deformation
thereof. A further object is to provide a means
whereby the pipe end is effectively gripped so
that the coupling is particularly suitable for use
in locations where vibrations might tend to loosen
a coupling of normal construction. The way in
which these objects are to be achieved is
described.
