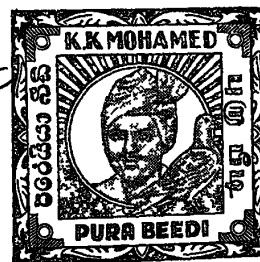

"Starting gate for horse-racing"

Abstract—This invention relates to a starting gate for horse racing.

The nature of the invention can be ascertained from claims 1 and 2 which read as follows —

1. Starting gate for horse-racing, comprising at each side of the race-course a tape-support movable alongside the course and to which are adapted to be detachably secured the respective ends of starting tapes adapted to extend across the course, tape-carrying means movable up an inclined ramp at each side of the course and to which said ends of said tapes may be transferred from said movable supports, means for transferring the tapes from said supports to said tape-carrying means, and means for moving said tape-carrying means up the respective inclined ramps

2. Starting gate according to claim 1, characterized in that the tapes are mounted at each end on a supporting means detachably secured to the movable support by a detachable pin or the equivalent a gap being left between the head of the said pin and the support
