KNOW Ye that by virtue of the powers vested in me by section 15 of the Ceylon (Constitution) Order in Council, 1946, I, Oliver Ernest Goonetilleke, Governor-General, do by this Proclamation prorogue Parliament with effect from the midnight of the Twenty-seventh day of April, 1955, and fix the Seventh day of June, 1955, as the date for the commencement of the next session of Parliament
