THE REVENUE PROTECTION ORDINANCE

ORDER

WHEREAS the Cabinet has during the present session of Parliament approved of the introduction into the House of Representatives of a resolution whereby, if such resolution be carried, export duty on the goods specified in column I of the Schedule hereto will be altered

Now, therefore, in pursuance of the powers vested in me by section 2 of the Revenue Protection Ordinance (Chapter 191), read with the Proclamation under section 88 of the Ceylon (Constitution) Order in Council, 1946, published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 9,773 of September 24, 1947, I, Mahabala Don Henry Jayawardena, Minister of Finance, do hereby order the Principal Collector of Customs from midnight of 15th/16th June, 1955, to demand and levy on the goods specified in column I of that Schedule (in lieu of the existing export duty payable thereon under Customs Ordinance), the export duty at the rate set out in column II of that Schedule
