THE COURTS ORDINANCE

Order under Section 5

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by section 5 of the Courts Ordinance (Chapter 6), as modified by the Proclamation published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 9,773 of September 24, 1947, I, Eric Bird Wikramanayake, Minister of Justice, do by this Order, after consultation with the Judges of the Supreme Court—

- (1) alter the limits of the Districts of-
 - (a) Avissawella as defined in the Order published in Gazette No. 10,168 of October 27, 1950;
 - (b) Ratnapura as defined in the Order published in Gazette No. 10,024 of September 30, 1949;
 - (c) Kandy as defined in the Order published in Gasette No 10,110 of June 9, 1950; and
 - (d) Anuradhapura as defined in the First Schedule to that Ordinance,

by substituting therefor the limits set out in Part I of the Schedule hereto; and

Report

The first complaint came from a few fishermen resident at Piyadigama, and I have noted them as petitioners.

The respondents also lodged a later complaint and are resident at Kataluwa, which adjoins

Piyadıgama

Petitioners claimed exclusive fishing rights in a harbour between the 83rd and the 84th mileposts on the Galle-Matara Road, at Pıyadigama, and base their claim on long usage They led little evidence of such usage, and their own witness deposed that a previous date, when their relations were amicable, brought in Piyadigama fisherfolk to join in this fishing. They ply this trade with rod and line. They have no Madels. Kataluwa fishermen shared in this fishing, and at

Clearly, there is no foundation, either in law or in past custom, for any claim of exclusive right to fish in this harbour

Recently, the Kataluwa fishermen have re-frained from using this harbour, since one of their set, a soldier returned from the war in the Middle East exploded dynamite and was gaoled for it. The salutary sentence of imprisonment on this rowdy seems to have scared the other Kataluwa men away.

But their right to fish in this bay and to use the posts, which they and the Piyadigama men have planted there in the sea, remains unaltered.

I have explained this fact to both parties and arranged a division of this bay, which allots twothirds of the bay, and the posts in that two-thirds portion, to the Piyadigama men, and the other one-third to the Kataluwa men.

I have fixed that proportion because the Kataluwa men have a large number of similar bays

available for their use in their own village.

Officers of the Fisheries Department have, at my suggestion and with the concurrence of the parties, set up 2 posts, one on the beach, and another in the sea 20 yards off, to fix the boun-I have advised the Piyadigama men to daries confine their operations to the two-third portion and the Kataluwa men to confine their labours to their one-third portion. That is the simplest way to prevent warfare.

I think that no further action is required.
