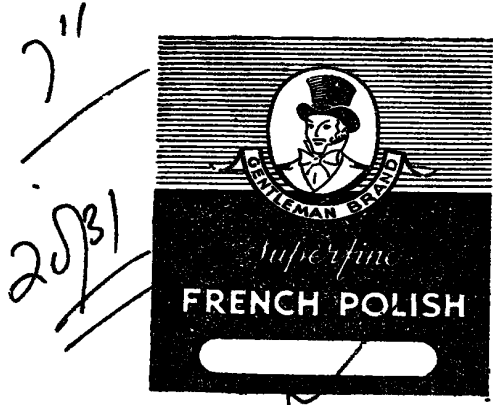

The invention comprises as its main feature means for the adjustment of the assembly table and also for the combination therewith of novel means whereby nails are fed for each operation of the machine to any selected number of the nailing guns with which the machine is supplied. The machine is described and shown as being concerned with a set of six operations in which the work assembly table is positioned at three different levels for different sets of operations These may be varied to suit the conditions

Abstract—This invention relates to the control of flow of powdered material through an orifice

The object of the invention is to overcome the difficulty of the powder periodically clogging the orifice, resulting in the rate of delivery being irregular The invention consists in a method of facilitating the steady flow of powdered material through an orifice by blowing air or other gas into the material adjacent to the orifice—thereby "aerating" it This is achieved by having a container with an outlet aperture for the powdered material and means for directing a flow of air or other gas into the mass of powdered material in the container to the said outlet aperture
