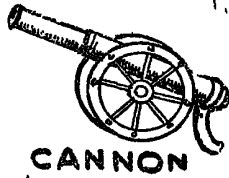

Abstract—This invention relates to food products. The nature of the invention can be ascertained from claims 15 and 16 which read as follows:—

15. A protein food product which comprises a combination of additive and substantially discrete particles

of a heat stable chewy gel or of a gel precursor which on heating under cooking conditions forms a product having a texture simulating that of meat or meat products

16. A process for the manufacture of a protein food product which includes the step of forming a gel precursor by adjusting a protein system consisting essentially of protein and water to a condition in which it is capable of forming a chewy protein gel.

"An improved method of manufacturing plastic shuttlecocks."

Abstract.—The nature of the invention can be ascertained from Claims 1 and 2 which read as follows:—

1. A tool for the injection moulding of plastic shuttlecocks comprising male and female parts partly conical and embodying grooves in the conical portions in which the stems and the ribs of the skirt of the shuttlecock will set, the tool being characterised in that subsidiary stem grooves are provided in the tool between the main stem grooves.

2. A tool for the injection moulding of plastic shuttlecocks as in Claim 1 and characterised in that rib grooves in the conical portion of the female tool are machined with one side of each groove substantially parallel to the principal axis of the conical portion of the tool, this side being extended until it runs out of the tool away from the small end of the conical portion.

"Shuttlecock and method of making."

Abstract—This invention relates to shuttlecocks of the type in which the skirt is moulded. The nature of the invention can be ascertained from Claims 1 and 2 which read as follows —

1. A shuttlecock comprising a cap and a moulded skirt composed of an upper and a lower part, and incorporating stems which are thicker where they leave the cap than material between the stems in the lower skirt and are flared outwardly from the cap, and moulded integrally, and characterised in that each stem has integral with it and grown from it during a production operation a plurality of ribs projecting from it in the area of the skirt remote from the cap this area being referred to as the lower skirt.

2. A shuttlecock as in Claim 1 and characterised in that at least one of the ribs makes a circumferential connection between the stems in the area of the lower skirt

"Improved tapping tool for grading trees or plants producing latex or other useful saps."

Abstract.—The nature of the invention can be ascertained from Claims 1 and 2 which read as follows.—

1. A tapping tool for grading trees or plants producing latex or other saps, with a view to discovering those likely in the future to prove high yielders, in which a support carrying one or more incising knives is provided with, or is so formed as to engage and be movable along, a visible scale graduated with lines or similar markings whereby the position of the one or more knives can be regulated in relation to a mark on the stem of the tree or plant, either directly or with reference to a preceding incision

2. A tapping tool, according to Claim 1, in which a longitudinal support is provided with incising knives located towards one end thereof and at the opposite end is provided integrally with the visible scale.
