Food Price Order No. KD—37.

RICE (WHOLESALE AND RETAIL)

### THE CONTROL OF PRICES ACT, No. 29 OF 1950

#### Order

BY virtue of the powers vested in the Assistant Controller of Prices (Food) by Section 4 read with Section 3 (2) of the Control of Prices Act, No 29 of 1950, I, Saravanamuttu Navaratnathan, Assistant Controller of Prices (Food), Kandy District and Uda-Hewaheta Division in the Nuwara Eliya District, do, by this Order—

- (i) revoke, with effect from May 30, 1955, Food Price Order No KD—35, dated October 19, 1953, published in *Ceylon Government Gazette* No 10,604 of October 23, 1953, fixing maximum prices of rice for the Kandy District and Uda-Hewaheta Division in the Nuwara Eliya District,
- (ii) fix, with effect from May 30, 1955, the prices specified in column 2 of the First Schedule hereto, to be the maximum wholesale prices per 80 measures nett and per 112 measures nett, respectively, above which rice shall not be sold by wholesale in the areas mentioned in the corresponding entries in column 1 of the First Schedule hereto,
- (iii) fix, with effect from May 30, 1955, the prices specified in column 2 of the Second Schedule hereto, to be the maximum retail prices per measure above which rice shall not be sold by retail in the areas mentioned in the corresponding entries in column 1 of the Second Schedule hereto
- (iv) direct, for the purposes of this Order—
  - (a) that any sale of any quantity of rice for the purpose of resale shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale,
  - (b) that any sale of any quantity of rice for the purpose of consumption or use shall be deemed to be a sale by retail, and
  - (c) "measure" shall be deemed to be the standard quart dry measure.
- (v) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, no person shall sell any rice which is adulterated with any other article,
- (vi) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, every trader who has any rice in his possession or under his control at any place, shall exhibit conspicuously at that place a notice in which there shall be set out the maximum prices fixed by this Order in that area,

(vii) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, every person who sells any rice by wholesale shall, and every person who sells any rice by retail shall on demand, give the purchaser thereof a receipt in which there shall be set out—

(a) the date of the sale,

(b) the weight of the rice sold,

(c) the price paid for the quantity of the rice sold: and

(d) the nature of the transaction, that is to say, whether the sale was by wholesale or by retail.

## PADDY (WHOLESALE AND RETAIL)

## THE CONTROL OF PRICES ACT, No. 29 OF 1950

## Order

BY virtue of powers vested in me by Section 4, read with section 3 (ii) of the Control of Prices Act, No. 29 of 1950, I, Sandirasegaram Sivasubramaniam, Assistant Controller of Prices (Food), for the Batticaloa District do by this order :—

- (i) fix with effect from May 30, 1955, prices specified in column 2 of the First Schedule hereto to be the maximum wholesale prices per 80 measures above which paddy shall not be sold by wholesale in the areas mentioned in the corresponding entries in column 1 of the same schedule ;
- (ii) fix with effect from May 30, 1955, prices specified in column 2 of the Second Schedule hereto to be the maximum retail prices per measure above which paddy shall not be sold in the areas mentioned in the corresponding entries in column 1 of the same schedule ;
- (iii) direct that for the purpose of this order—
  - (a) any sale of any quantity of paddy for the purpose of re-sale shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale ;
  - (b) any sale of any quantity of paddy for the purpose of consumption or use by the purchaser shall be deemed to be a sale by retail ;
  - (c) "measure" shall be deemed to be a standard quart dry measure ;

- (iv) direct that no person shall sell paddy which is adulterated with any other article,
- (v) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this order every trader who sells paddy shall exhibit conspicuously at that place a notice in which there should be set out the maximum prices fixed by this order in that area,
- (vi) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this order every person who sells any paddy by wholesale shall, and every person who sells paddy by retail shall on demand, give the purchaser thereof the receipt in which there should be set out—
- (a) the date of sale;
- (b) the quantity of paddy sold;
- (c) the price paid for the quantity of paddy sold; and
- (d) the nature of transaction, i. e. whether the sale was by wholesale or by retail;
- (vii) direct that when any paddy is sold the maximum prices fixed by this order shall include the price of the wrapper or container, if any, in which such paddy is sold.
