- (v) direct that no person shall sell paddy which is adulterated with any other article ,

- (vi) direct that when any paddy is sold the maximum prices fixed by this Order shall include the price of the wrapper or container, if any, in which such paddy is sold ,

- (vii) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, every trader who has any paddy in his possession or under his control at any place, shall exhibit conspicuously at that place a notice in which there shall be set out the maximum prices fixed by this Order in that area ; and

- (viii) direct that every person who sells paddy, by retail shall on demand, and every person who sells paddy by wholesale shall, give the purchaser of that paddy a receipt in which there shall be set out—

- (a) the date of sale ;
- (b) the quantity of paddy sold ,
- (c) the price paid for the quantity of paddy sold ; and

- (d) the nature of the transaction, that is to say, whether the sale was by wholesale or by retail

- (i) revoke with effect from May 30, 1955, the Price Order mentioned below in so far as it fixes the maximum prices of rice for the Badulla District.
 - (a) Food Price Order No. B. 11 dated October 17, 1953, and published in *Government Gazette* No. 10,802 of October 19, 1953.
- (ii) fix the prices specified in columns 2, 3 and 4 of the first schedule hereto to be the maximum wholesale prices per 112 measures, 80 measures and 48 measures nett, respectively above which rice shall not be sold by wholesale in the areas mentioned in the corresponding entries in column 1 of the same schedule.
- (iii) fix the prices specified in column 2 of the second schedule hereto to be the maximum retail prices per measure above which rice shall not be sold in the areas mentioned in the corresponding entries in column 1 of the same schedule.
- (iv) direct that for the purpose of this Order—
 - (a) any sale of any quantity of rice for the purpose of resale shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale;
 - (b) any sale of any quantity of rice for the purpose of consumption or use by the purchaser shall be deemed to be a sale by retail;
 - (c) "measure" shall be deemed to be the standard quart dry measure,

- (v) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this order, no person shall sell any rice which is adulterated with any other article.
- (vi) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this order every trader, who has any rice in his possession or under his control at any place, shall exhibit conspicuously at that place a notice in which there shall be set out the maximum prices fixed by this order in that area.
- (vii) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this order every person who sells any rice by wholesale shall and every person who sells rice by retail shall on demand, give the purchaser thereof a receipt in which there shall be set out—
- the date of sale,
 - the quantity of rice sold, mentioning the variety,
 - the price paid for the quantity of rice sold, and
 - the nature of the transaction, i.e., whether the sale was by wholesale or by retail.
