#### GENERAL CONDITIONS APPLICABLE TO APPOINTMENTS TO POSTS IN THE PUBLIC SERVICE ADVERTISED IN THE “CEYLON GOVERNMENT GAZETTE”

**Allowances.**—Unless otherwise stated, Rent Allowance, temporary Cost of Living Allowance and temporary Special Living Allowance are payable according to Government Regulations.

**Conditions of Service.**—Appointments will be subject to the Public Service Commission Rules, the Financial Regulations, the Regulations of the Manual of Procedure, Departmental Orders or Regulations, and any other orders or regulations issued from time to time by the Government.

**Terms of Engagement.**—(i) In the case of appointments to the non-pensionable establishment (excluding those on daily rates of pay) appointees will be required to contribute 5 per cent of their salary to the Public Service Provident Fund, and they will be allowed to contribute, at their option, a further 5 per cent. The Government contribution, in either case, will be equal to 7½ per cent. of the salary paid in at the close of each financial year.

(ii) Appointees may be required to furnish security in terms of the Public Officers' (Security) Ordinance, if so required by the Head of their Department.

(iii) Appointees other than those already in the Public Service will be required to pass a medical examination by a Government Medical Officer as to their physical fitness to serve in any part of the Island.

**Qualifications required.**—Every applicant must furnish satisfactory proof that he is a Ceylonese. A “Ceylonese” is a citizen of Ceylon by descent or by registration.

**War Service Concession.**—Provided they are qualified in all other respects, ex-Servicemen of Her Majesty's Fighting Forces and full-time members of the Auxiliary Fire, Air Raid Precautions

and Civil Defence Services (excluding those who had left these Services of their own accord), will be allowed to deduct periods of such service commencing from September 3, 1939, at the earliest, and up to December 31, 1949, at the latest, from their ages for purposes of eligibility alone, provided that they joined the Forces before August 15, 1945, and that such service was satisfactory and continuous.

**Other Requirements.**—(i) Applications from officers of the Public Service, who are qualified, must be forwarded through the Heads of their respective Departments. In the case of applications from officers holding permanent posts in the Public Service, the Heads of the Departments concerned should, in forwarding the applications state whether or not they are prepared to release the applicants (if selected) in accordance with Administrative Regulation 109 of the Manual of Procedure

APPLICATIONS are invited from Public Officers for the award of training facilities in New Zealand for the study of Mechanized Accounting Methods as obtaining in the New Zealand Postal Administration. The training will be for a period of about 6 months

### SURVEY DEPARTMENT

#### Post of Assistant Superintendent of Surveys

APPLICATIONS are invited for the selection of one candidate to be trained for appointment to a post of Assistant Superintendent of Surveys in the Survey Department. Applications, which should be on a special form obtainable from this office, should reach me on or before the following dates:—

(a) *On probation.*—During the two-year period of training in Ceylon he will be paid an allowance of Rs. 3,000 per annum plus temporary cost of living allowance, according to Government regulations, and during the period of training in the United Kingdom which will be about one year, he will be paid a supplement to bring his allowance to £360 per annum plus a temporary increase of £60.

The candidate will receive free passage to England and back. The University and/or Training Centre fees and an outfit allowance of Rs. 500 will also be paid. A family allowance of Rs. 1,500 per annum will be paid during the period of training in the United Kingdom if the candidate is married.

(b) *On appointment.*—Rs. 4,800—Rs. 12,720 per annum by 10 annual increments of Rs. 360 each and 9 of Rs. 480 each (two years on Rs. 10,800;

efficiency bars before Rs. 8,040 and Rs. 11,280). If appointed thereafter as Superintendent of Surveys, Salary Scale will be Rs. 13,200 to Rs. 15,000 by 3 annual increments of Rs. 600 each.

(ii) Travelling expenses will be reimbursed in accordance with Financial and Departmental Regulations.

3. *Period and terms of engagement.*—(i) Probationary period of 3 years after which, if service has been satisfactory, and if the officer qualifies for appointment as Assistant Superintendent of Surveys, he will be placed on the permanent and pensionable establishment. The probationary period of 3 years will run from the date of entering the Survey Training School at Diyatalawa.

(ii) The selected candidate will be required to—

(a) pass a medical examination as to his physical fitness to serve in any part of the Island, and good eyesight;

(b) enter into an agreement and bond with two approved sureties, each with assets to the value of the entire cost of study and training for the due fulfilment of the terms and conditions contained in the Agreement and Bond to pursue faithfully and diligently the course of studies and training in Ceylon and in the United Kingdom and to serve the Government of Ceylon in the Survey Department, as an Assistant Superintendent of Surveys for a specified period (to be determined by Government) from the date of his appointment to that post. This Agreement and Bond will come into operation from the date of entering the Survey Training School at Diyatalawa;

(c) undergo a practical course in Surveying and Levelling, most probably for two years in Ceylon, partly in Diyatalawa and partly attached to Survey Parties in the field, to be followed by a course in England. If no vacancy occurs in England at the end of this course, the candidate will be given further training until a vacancy occurs;

(d) undergo a course at a Survey Training Centre in the United Kingdom and/or a post-Graduate Course at the University of Cambridge;

(e) Prior to his departure to England, to present himself before a special medical board at Colombo with a view to ascertaining whether he is physically fit to undergo a course of study in countries with conditions of climate and environment materially differing from those obtaining in Ceylon.

(iii) If the candidate is reported on favourably by the training authorities he will, on his return to Ceylon and on completion of his training, receive appointment as Assistant Superintendent of Surveys on the permanent and pensionable establishment of the Survey Department and will be eligible for further promotion.
