GENERAL CONDITIONS APPLICABLE TO APPOINTMENTS TO POSTS IN THE PUBLIC SERVICE ADVERTISED IN THE "CEYLON GOVERNMENT GAZETTE"

Allowances.—Unless otherwise stated, Rent Allowance, temporary Cost of Living Allowance and temporary Special Living Allowance are payable according to Government Regulations.

Conditions of Service.—Appointments will be subject to the Public Service Commission Rules, the Financial Regulations, the Regulations of the Manual of Procedure, Departmental Orders or Regulations, and any other orders or regulations issued from time to time by the Government.

Terms of Engagement.—(i) In the case of appointments to the non-pensionable establishment (excluding those on daily rates of pay) appointees will be required to contribute 5 per cent. of their salary to the Public Service Provident Fund, and they will be allowed to contribute, at their option, a further 5 per cent. The Government contribution, in either case, will be equal to 7½ per cent. of the salary paid in at the close of each financial year.

(ii) Appointees may be required to furnish security in terms of the Public Officers (Security) Ordinance, if so required by the Head of their Department.

(iii) Appointees other than those already in the Public Service will be required to pass a medical examination by a Government Medical Officer as to their physical fitness to serve in any part of the Island.

Qualifications required.—Every applicant must furnish satisfactory proof that he is a Ceylonese. A "Ceylonese" is a citizen of Ceylon by descent or by registration.

War Service Concession.—Provided they are qualified in all other respects, ex-Servicemen of Her Majesty's Fighting Forces and full-time members of the Auxiliary Fire, Air Raid Precautions

and Civil Defence Services (excluding those who had left these Services of their own accord), will be allowed to deduct periods of such service commencing from September 3, 1939, at the earliest, and up to December 31, 1949, at the latest, from their ages for purposes of eligibility alone, provided that they joined the Forces before August 15, 1945, and that such service was satisfactory and continuous.

Other Requirements.—(i) Applications from officers of the Public Service, who are qualified, must be forwarded through the Heads of their respective Departments. In the case of applications from officers holding permanent posts in the Public Service, the Heads of the Departments concerned should, in forwarding the applications, state whether or not they are prepared to release the applicants (if selected) in accordance with Administrative Regulation 109 of the Manual of Procedure.

(ii) Candidates may be required to present themselves for interview at an appointed time and place. No travelling or other expenses will be paid in this connection.

(iii) Anyone desiring to recommend a candidate should do so by giving a testimonial. Any form of canvassing or attempt to influence the selection of a candidate will disqualify such candidate.

(iv) Any statement in the application which is found to be incorrect will render the applicant liable to disqualification if the inaccuracy is discovered before the selection, and to dismissal if discovered after the selection.

(v) Applications not conforming in every respect with the requirements of this advertisement will be rejected.

APPLICATIONS are invited for part-time Relief Announcers (Western) in the Department of Broadcasting. Employment will be on a casual basis at the rate of Re. 1.50 per hour. EXAMINATION FOR APPOINTMENT TO CLASS IV OF THE ACCOUNTANTS' SERVICE, 1955.

APPLICATIONS are invited from applicants possessing the necessary qualifications as set out in this notice for appointment to Class IV of the Accountants' Service.

Method of Application

2 (a) Application on forms to be obtained from the Office of the Secretary, Public Service Commission, must be addressed to the Secretary, Public Service Commission, P. O. Box No. 500, Colombo, and must reach that officer on or before August 1, 1955.

(b) Applicants who are not already in Government Service should name two referees, who, from their personal knowledge of the candidate, can testify to his character and capacity.

(c) Applicants in Government Service should send their application forms through the Heads of their Departments.

(d) No allegation that an application form or letter respecting such form has been lost or delayed in the post can be considered. Candidates who delay their applications until the last few days will do so at their own risk.

(e) Acknowledgments of applications will be sent, and any applicant who has sent in his application but has not received an acknowledgement of it within a reasonable time should at once write to the Secretary, Public Service Commission. Failure to comply with this provision will deprive the applicant of any claim to consideration.

Number of Vacancies

3. (a) It is estimated that the number of vacancies will be 15. The Public Service Commission may omit to fill any or all the vacancies if it considers this necessary in the public interest.

(b) The Public Service Commission reserves the right to cancel this examination if it considers it expedient in the public interest to do so. It is open to the Public Service Commission to postpone the examination should it consider it necessary.

Qualifications of Candidates

4. Every applicant who must be a male, must possess the following minimum qualifications.

(a) He must, if he is not already in the service of the Government of Ceylon, be a Ceylonese. A "Ceylonese" is a citizen of Ceylon by descent or registration.

(b) He must have been born not earlier than 1st August, 1913. Temporary Accountants and Acting Accountants appointed on the results of Accountants' Service Examinations with not less than 2 years continuous service as such on 1st August, 1955, will be permitted to sit for the Examination regardless of age.

(c) He must be of good moral character and of sound constitution, physically fit for service in any part of the Island. A successful applicant who is not already in Government Service will be required to pass a medical examination.

(d) He must be either—

(I) A Chartered Accountant ;

Incorporated Accountant ;

One who has passed the Final Examination of the Ceylon Board of Accountancy ; or
One who possesses qualifications in Accountancy which in the opinion of the Public Service Commission are equivalent to those specified above. Service under articles is essential.

or

(II) A member of the Executive Clerical Class of the General Clerical Service, Customs Clerical Service, Railway Clerical Service, and Postal Clerical Service ; a member of the Special Class, Class I and Class II of the Survey Department Clerks' and Draughtsmen's Service ; a member of the Special Class, Class I and Class II of the Railway Station Masters' Service who on September 30, 1946, was a member of the Railway Clerical Service ; a member of the Special Class, Class I and Class II of the Postmasters' and Signallers' Service ; a member of Grade I and Grade II of the Local Government Service Commission Clerical Service ; or a member of the Special Class, Class I and Class II of Colombo Electricity Supply Clerical Service and the Electrical Department Clerical Service ; a member of Grade I or Grade II of the Parliamentary Clerical Service ; provided that in the case of officers in Grade II or Class II of the Services mentioned above only those will be eligible who either have completed ten years service in Grade II or Class II, or else are on a salary of not less than Rs. 2,820 per annum on August 1, 1955.

Provided further that those who are holders of the Accountancy Diploma of the Ceylon Technical College will be eligible if they have completed not less than 5 years' service in Grade II or Class II on that date.

Method of Selection

5. (a) Applicants qualified in term of paragraph 4 (d) (I) will be interviewed by the Public Service Commission and selections made on this interview. The date and place of the interview will be notified to these applicants in due course.

(b) A competitive examination will be held for the selection of applicants qualified in terms of paragraph 4 (d) (II). The examination will be in two parts, viz., (1) a written examination and (2) a *viva voce* examination. The written examination will be held in Colombo in or about August, 1955. The exact date and place of examination will be notified to candidates in due course.

The *viva voce* examination will be held on a date to be communicated to applicants after the written examination. This examination will be restricted to applicants who attain a sufficiently high standard in the written examination.

Scheme of Examination

6. The Scheme of examination referred to in paragraph 5 (b) will be as follows :

- (i) Book-keeping and Accounts 200 marks.
A written paper of 3 hours' duration on Book-keeping and Accounts including Auditing and Cost Accounts. A choice of questions will be given.

Candidates will be expected to have a knowledge of—

- (a) The theory and practice of single and double entry Book-keeping including the preparation of Production, Trading and Profit and Loss Accounts and Balance Sheets.
(b) Double Account System.
(c) Stores Accounts.
(d) Elements of Costing.
(e) The functions of the Minister of Finance, the Secretary to the Treasury, the Deputy Secretary to the Treasury, the Permanent Secretaries, and the Auditor-General.
(f) The Principles of Auditing.
(g) The audit of the Accounts of Government departments.

- (ii) Government Financial Regulations and Financial Procedure 200 marks.
A written paper of 3 hours' duration on the Government Financial Regulations and Financial Procedure.

Candidates should have a working knowledge of the Financial Regulations of Government and Financial Procedure as they relate to Revenue and Expenditure, Annual and Supplementary Estimates, Loan Funds, Public Debt, Establishments, Stores and Tenders, Imprests and Advances, Financial Sanctions, and the Accounts of the Island. Special consideration will be given to a candidate's ability to express himself clearly in English.

- (iii) *Viva voce* Test 200 marks.
The marks scored by candidates in the written examination will not be available to the board conducting this test.

Conditions of Service

7. Persons not already in Government Service will be appointed on probation for two years.

8. The salary scale is Rs 4,080 per annum rising by annual increments of Rs. 360 to Rs. 8,040 per annum. If the candidate selected is a Chartered, Incorporated or Ceylon Registered Accountant, he will be placed on an initial salary of Rs. 5,880 per annum. Candidates already in the service of the Ceylon Government who were appointed to the Public Service on or before April 24, 1933, will be eligible for the salary of £300 rising by five annual increments of £24 and five annual increments of £30 to £570 per annum.

9. Rent allowance will be paid in terms of the existing regulations.

10. The grant of leave and other conditions of service will be in accordance with Financial Regulations.

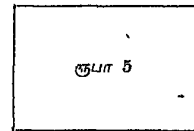
