GENERAL CONDITIONS APPLICABLE TO APPOINTMENTS TO POSTS IN THE PUBLIC SERVICE ADVERTISED IN THE “CEYLON GOVERNMENT GAZETTE”

Allowances.—Unless otherwise stated, Rent Allowance, temporary Cost of Living Allowance and temporary Special Living Allowance are payable according to Government Regulations.

Conditions of Service.—Appointments will be subject to the Public Service Commission Rules, the Financial Regulations, the Regulations of the Manual of Procedure, Departmental Orders or Regulations, and any other orders or regulations issued from time to time by the Government.

Terms of Engagement.—(i) In the case of appointments to the non-pensionable establishment (excluding those on daily rates of pay) appointees will be required to contribute 5 per cent. of their salary to the Public Service Provident Fund, and they will be allowed to contribute, at their option, a further 5 per cent. The Government contribution, in either case, will be equal to 7½ per cent. of the salary paid in at the close of each financial year.

(ii) Appointees may be required to furnish security in terms of the Public Officers' (Security) Ordinance, if so required by the Head of their Department.

(iii) Appointees other than those already in the Public Service will be required to pass a medical examination by a Government Medical Officer as to their physical fitness to serve in any part of the Island.

Qualifications required.—Every applicant must furnish satisfactory proof that he is a Ceylonese. A “Ceylonese” is a citizen of Ceylon by descent or by registration.

War Service Concession.—Provided they are qualified in all other respects, ex-Servicemen of Her Majesty's Fighting Forces and full-time members of the Auxiliary Fire, Air Raid Precautions

and Civil Defence Services (excluding those who had left these Services of their own accord), will be allowed to deduct periods of such service commencing from September 3, 1939, at the earliest, and up to December 31, 1949, at the latest, from their ages for purposes of eligibility alone, provided that they joined the Forces before August 15, 1945, and that such service was satisfactory and continuous.

Other Requirements.—(i) Applications from officers of the Public Service, who are qualified, must be forwarded through the Heads of their respective Departments. In the case of applications from officers holding permanent posts in the Public Service, the Heads of the Departments concerned should, in forwarding the applications state whether or not they are prepared to release the applicants (if selected) in accordance with Administrative Regulation 109 of the Manual of Procedure.

(ii) Candidates may be required to present themselves for interview at an appointed time and place. No travelling or other expenses will be paid in this connection.

(iii) Anyone desiring to recommend a candidate should do so by giving a testimonial. Any form of canvassing or attempt to influence the selection of a candidate will disqualify such candidate.

(iv) Any statement in the application which is found to be incorrect will render the applicant liable to disqualification if the inaccuracy is discovered before the selection, and to dismissal if discovered after the selection.

(v) Applications not conforming in every respect with the requirements of this advertisement will be rejected.

Posts of Training Mistresses, Government Training Colleges

APPLICATIONS will be received by the Director of Education, Branch T. C., Education Office, Malay Street, Slave Island, on or before June 2, 1955, for the posts of Training Mistresses in the following Training Colleges:—

2. *Salary scale.*—The salary scale attached to the posts is Rs. 2,400—10 of 120 and 5 of 180—Rs. 4,500 (scale approved in the current years estimates).

3. *Educational and other qualifications required.*—

- (i) Candidates should be Graduates in Science with two years' teaching experience after graduation or should be Secondary Trained Teachers who have specialised in Science at the Maharagama Training College and should have at least two years' teaching experience. The candidates should be able to teach any two of the following:—Chemistry, Physics, Zoology, Botany and Biology. In the case of Secondary Trained Teachers preference will be given to those who have passed the Inter Science Examination.
- (ii) Teachers who have now undergone a Specialist Course in Science at the Government Training College, Maharagama, too may apply for the posts. If any officer of this category is selected for appointment she will be placed on a salary of Rs. 2,400 p.a. for 2 years and will begin to draw increments thereafter.
- (iii) Candidates should not be less than 25 years and not more than 50 years of age on May 13, 1955. The upper age limit is not applicable in the case of officers who are in Government Service.

4. *Special conditions.*—

- (i) Candidates should possess a very good working knowledge of Sinhalese/Tamil, but the Director may call upon any person to qualify in Sinhalese/Tamil within a period (to be specified) by him.
- (ii) The selected candidates will, in the first instance, be attached to any one of the Training Colleges referred to above but are liable to transfer.

Posts of Assistant Teachers

APPLICATIONS from men and women candidates, who satisfy the conditions in paragraph 4 below, are invited for the posts of Assistant Teachers in the Education Department. 2. The salary scales attached to the posts are as follows :—

- (a) Trained Graduates —Rs. 3,120 rising up to Rs. 5,040 per annum by 4 annual increments of Rs. 120 and 8 of Rs. 180.
- (b) Graduates —Rs. 2,160 rising up to Rs. 4,320 per annum by 12 annual increments of Rs. 120 and 4 of Rs. 180.
- (c) Secondary Trained Teachers.—Rs. 1,680 rising up to Rs. 4,320 per annum by 16 annual increments of Rs. 120 and 4 of Rs. 180 with an efficiency bar before Rs. 2,040.
- (d) Teachers who have passed an intermediate examination of the University of London or who have completed a course of studies for the final examination for a degree of the University of Ceylon after passing the appropriate first examination of that University :—Rs. 1,200 rising up to Rs. 2,424 per annum by 17 annual increments of Rs. 72.

N.B.—Teachers from Schools under the Free Scheme will be placed on the appropriate point of their scales of salary on appointment as Teachers under Government.

3. The posts are pensionable under the School Teachers' Pension Scheme. The selected candidates will, if not in the permanent pensionable service under Government as Teachers, be appointed on probation for two years.

4. Every applicant must furnish satisfactory proof that he/she :—

Candidates should be capable of teaching any one or combination of subjects prescribed in the relevant Public Examination syllabuses for pupils in Secondary Schools,
- (c) possesses a good knowledge of Sinhalese or Tamil. Preference will be given to those who have passed at least in Language and Literature in Sinhalese or Tamil at the G. C. E. (Ordinary Level) or equivalent Examination, and
- (d) is of good character and physically sound.

- (i) certificate of registration of birth. (Baptismal certificates or certificates issued for the purpose of the Code of Regulations for Assisted Schools will not be accepted);
- (ii) certificates of the academic and professional qualifications;
