GENERAL CONDITIONS APPLICABLE TO APPOINTMENTS TO POSTS IN THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT SERVICE ADVERTISED IN PART IV OF THE "CEYLON GOVERNMENT GAZETTE"

1. *Allowances.*—Unless otherwise stated, Rent Allowance, temporary Cost of Living Allowance and temporary Special Living Allowance are payable according to Government Rates and Conditions.

2. *Conditions of Service.*—Appointments will be subject to the provisions of the Local Government Service Ordinance, No. 43 of 1945, as amended by the Local Government Service (Transitional Provisions) Ordinance, No. 5 of 1946, any further amendments of Ordinance No. 43 of 1945, and the Regulations made thereunder, and other conditions of service as laid down by the Commission from time to time.

3. *Terms of Engagement.*—The posts specified in the schedule published in Part IV of the *Ceylon Government Gazette* No. 10,432 of August 8, 1952, and other posts added thereto from time to time while held by members of the Local Government Service other than females are pensionable under the Local Government Service Pension Scheme Regulations, 1952.

(a) The pension rights of officers serving under Government will be conserved if released under Section 21 of the Government Minutes on Pensions, and transferred to pensionable posts in the Local Government Service.

(b) In the case of employees of Local Authorities who hold pensionable posts under the Pension

By-laws or Rules of the Local Authorities, the payment of their pension on ultimate retirement will be governed by the Pension By-laws or Rules of the Local Authority in whose employ they were on the date immediately preceding the date of their transfer to the Local Government Service, in terms of Section 48 of the Local Government Service Ordinance, No. 43 of 1945, as amended by the Local Government Service (Amendment) Act, No. 8 of 1949.

(c) All appointees to pensionable posts other than females, officers above the age of 55 and officers who were holding pensionable posts in Government Service on the date immediately prior to their appointment to the Local Government Service, are required to contribute 4 per cent. of their salary to the Local Government Service Widows' and Orphans' Pension Fund established under the Local Government Service Widows' and Orphans' Pension Fund Regulations, 1952, published in the *Government Gazette Extraordinary* No. 10,429 of July 30, 1952. The Local Authority will contribute 3 per cent. of salary.

(d) Appointees may be required to furnish security either in cash or by Fidelity Guarantee Bond through a Guarantee Association approved by the Local Government Service Commission in a sum which may be decided upon by the Local Authority.

(e) Appointees not holding scheduled posts in the Local Government Service or permanent posts in the Public Service will be required to pass a medical examination by a duly qualified medical practitioner as to their physical fitness to serve in any part of the Island.

(f) The appointment will generally be on probation or subject to confirmation after a period of one year unless otherwise specified.

4. *Qualifications required.*—Every applicant must furnish satisfactory proof that he is a Ceylonese. The term "Ceylonese" for all purposes of recruitment to the Local Government Service is defined as a citizen of Ceylon by descent or by registration.

5. *War Service Concession.*—Provided they are qualified in all other respects, ex-Servicemen of Her Majesty's Fighting Forces and full-time members of the Auxiliary Fire, Air Raid Precautions and Civil Defence Services (excluding those who had left these Services of their own accord), will be allowed to deduct periods of such service (commencing from September 3, 1939, at the earliest and up to December 31, 1949, at the latest), from their ages for purposes of eligibility alone, provided that they joined the Forces before August 15, 1945, and that such service was satisfactory and continuous.

6. *Other Requirements.*—(i) Applications from those in a Local Body should be forwarded through the Municipal Commissioner or Chairman of the Local Authority in which they are serving.

(ii) Applications from officers in the Government Service should be forwarded through the Heads of their respective Departments. In the case of applications from officers holding permanent posts in the Government Service, the Head of the Department concerned should, when forwarding the application, state whether or not he is prepared to release the applicant if selected.

(iii) Candidates may be required to present themselves for interview or test at an appointed time and place. No travelling or other expenses will be paid in this connection.

(iv) Any person who desires to recommend a candidate may do so by giving a testimonial. Any form of direct or indirect canvassing or attempt to influence the selection of candidates will disqualify such candidates.

(v) Any statement in the application which is found to be incorrect will render the applicant liable to disqualification if the inaccuracy is discovered before the selection and to dismissal after the selection.

(vi) Applications not conforming in every respect with the requirements of this advertisement will be rejected.

THE URBAN COUNCILS ORDINANCE, No. 61 OF 1939

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by sections 2, 5, 6 and 30 of the Urban Councils Ordinance, No 61 of 1939, as modified by the Proclamation published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 9,773 of September 24, 1947, I, Christopher William Wijekoon Kannangara, Minister of Local Government, do hereby—

- (1) revoke, subject to the provisions of paragraph (4)—
- (a) the Proclamation published in *Gazette* No. 9,686 of March 28, 1947 (as amended by Order published in *Gazette* No 10,312 of October 26, 1951), in so far as that Proclamation relates to the limits of the town of Talawakele-Lindula, and
- (b) the Order published in *Gazette* No. 9,686 of March 28, 1947, relating to the number of members and the number and the limits of the wards of the town of Talawakele-Lindula ;
- (2) order that, subject to the provisions of paragraph (4), the limits of the town of Talawakele-Lindula shall be those defined in the First Schedule hereto ;
- (3) order that, subject to the provisions of paragraph (4), the Talawakele-Lindula Urban Council shall consist of seven members and the town of Talawakele-Lindula shall be divided into seven wards with the limits defined in the Second Schedule hereto ; and
- (4) declare that the provisions of paragraphs (1), (2) and (3) of this Order shall come into effect on the day immediately following the date of expiration of the term of office of the members of the Talawakele-Lindula Urban Council who are in office at the date hereof.

First Schedule

LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF TALAWAKELE-LINDULA

All that area of land situated in the Divisional Revenue Officers's Division of Kotmale, Nuwara Eliya District, Central Province; and bounded as follows—

North. By a line drawn from a point on the northern boundary of the main road from Kandy to Talawakele where it meets a line drawn in prolongation of the western boundary of the Urban Council Road, eastwards along the northern boundary of the said road till it meets the eastern boundary of the Railway line and reservation from Hatton to Nanu Oya ; thence south-eastwards and south-westwards along the eastern boundary of the said Railway line and reservation till it meets the centre line of the Great Western Estate Road ; thence southwards and eastwards along the centre line of the said Estate Road to the centre of its junction with Palmerston Road ; thence eastwards and northwards along the centre line of the Great Western Estate Road till it meets the line of Telephone Cable Posts ; thence south-eastwards along the said line of Telephone Cable Posts till it meets the right bank of Kotmale Ganga ; thence north-eastwards, south-eastwards and eastwards along the said bank till it meets the centre line of the foot path leading to the Estate Road, at the suspension bridge over the Kotmale Ganga near the Bearwell Tea Factory ; thence northwards along the centre line of the said foot path to the northern boundary of the said Estate Road ; thence eastwards along the northern boundary of the said Estate Road till it meets the centre line of the stream from where the said road turns southwards

East. By a line drawn from the last-mentioned point southwards and south-eastwards along the northern boundary of the said Estate Road to the junction where it meets the foot path east of Lamilier Factory ; thence south-eastwards along the eastern boundary of the said foot path till it meets the centre line of the channel ; thence south-eastwards, south-westwards and again south-eastwards along the centre line of the said channel till it meets the centre line of the road from Nawalapitiya to Nanu Oya at culvert No. 28/8 ; thence due south-westwards along a straight line to a distance of 21 chains.

South. By a line drawn from the last-mentioned point north-westwards along a straight line to the starting point of the dry stream ; thence north-westwards along the centre line of the said dry stream to the right bank of Kotmale Ganga ; thence

southwards along the said right bank to a point due east of the centre of the confluence of the Kotmale Ganga with the dry stream which falls through culvert No 27/13 on the road from Nawalapitiya to Agrapatana; thence due westwards along a straight line across the Kotmale Ganga and westwards along the centre line of the said dry stream to the centre of the said culvert No 27/13; thence due north-westwards along a straight line till it meets the western boundary of the Estate Road; thence northwards, north-westwards and south-westwards along the western and southern boundaries of the said Estate Road till it meets the line of Telephone Cable Posts near Belgravia Estate; thence north-westwards along the said line of Telephone Cable Posts till it meets the centre line of the channel; thence north-westwards and southwards along the centre line of the said channel till it meets the centre line of the stream; thence westwards along a straight line to a point 6 chains due south of culvert No. 25/14 on the main road from Nawalapitiya to Nanu Oya; thence westwards along straight lines joining points which are 6 chains due south from the successive culverts along the said road till it meets a point 6 chains due south of the culvert about 7 chains east of the 24th mile stone on the said road; thence south-westwards along a straight line till it meets the centre of the junction of the Estate Road leading to the bungalow in Middleton Estate with the Estate Road leading to the said estate from a point about 9 chains east of the 24th mile stone on the said road; thence north-westwards along a straight line to a point on the centre line of Glenomera Road at its elbow bend in Talawakele Estate

West. By-laws

SALE OF PROVISIONS

1. No person shall keep any shop or place (other than a market) for the sale of meat, fish, poultry, vegetables, rice, currysuffs or other perishable articles of food, except on a licence duly obtained in that behalf from the Chairman. Every such licence shall unless it is earlier cancelled under by-law 6, expire on the thirty-first day of December of the year in respect of which it is issued.

2. The owner or seller of meat, poultry, fish, vegetables, rice, currysuffs or other perishable articles of food in any shop or place (other than a market) shall keep the meat, poultry and fish apart from the vegetables, rice and currysuffs, and the poultry in baskets so made that the birds may not suffer unnecessary discomfort.

3. The Chairman or any person duly authorized by him in writing may inspect any shop (other than a market) used for the sale of meat, poultry, fish, fruit, vegetables, rice, currysuffs or other perishable articles of food for human consumption

4. (1) No meat shall be transported from any slaughter-house to any shop or place where meat is sold except in a box or vehicle which satisfies the conditions set out in the next following paragraph.

(2) (a) Every box used for the transport of meat must have the inside lined with zinc or other impermeable material and be fitted with a lid.

(b) Every vehicle used for the transport of meat must be provided with:—

- (i) a roof to protect the meat from the sun or rain or from contamination by flies or dust;
- (ii) a covering at each open end to screen the meat from public view; and
- (iii) a compartment, the inside of which is lined with zinc or other impermeable material for storing the meat

(3) Where any meat is transported in contravention of paragraph (1), the person liable for such contravention shall be the person on whose behalf or on whose directions the meat was so transported.

5. The holder of a licence to keep any shop or place (other than a market) for the sale of meat, poultry, fish, vegetables, rice, currysuffs or other articles of food shall—

- (a) keep affixed in a conspicuous position on the premises in which such trade is carried on, the licence obtained under by-law 1, or where such licence cannot be affixed cause a board to be affixed with the licence number and the name of the holder of the licence clearly painted in a conspicuous place on such premises; and
- (b) keep such premises in a clean and sanitary condition and close up all rat holes with cement and glass.

6. It shall be lawful for the Rural Court, in addition to any other punishment that it may impose, to cancel the licence of any licensee convicted twice or oftener of any breach of any of these by-laws relating to the sale of provisions, and the licensee shall not be entitled to any compensation in respect of the cancellation.

STRAY CATTLE

7. The charges payable before the removal of any animal impounded under by-law 3 (1) of Part XXIV of the Standard By-laws adopted by the Committee, shall be calculated at the following rates:—

For occupation, 50 cents per head for a day or part of a day.

For food (if supplied), 25 cents per head for a day or part of a day.

ABATEMENT OF NUISANCES

8. No person shall, within the administrative limits of the village area, by operating or causing or permitting any other person to operate any gramophone, wireless loud-speaker, amplifier, or other similar instrument, produce or reproduce or cause to be produced or reproduced any sound, which by reason of its volume or its repetition or its continuous nature, causes a nuisance to the occupants of the premises in the neighbourhood.

9. No proceedings shall be instituted in respect of any contravention of by-law 8 against any person operating or causing or permitting any other person to operate any instrument as aforesaid in any place other than a street, public place, shop or place of business, or a place which adjoins any street or public place and to which members of the public are admitted, unless—

- (a) complaint of nuisance is made to the Chairman in writing by not less than three house-holders of the neighbourhood affected by the nuisance;

- (b) written notice is served on the person by the Chairman setting out the nature of the complaint received and requiring that person to abate the nuisance forthwith or within a specified period; and
- (c) that person fails or refuses to comply with such notice forthwith on receipt thereof or within the period specified therein, as the case may be.

AMENDMENTS

10. The by-laws published in *Gazette* No. 8,737 of April 18, 1941, are hereby amended by the insertion, immediately after by-law 1, of the following new by-law:—

“1A No person shall, during the period of any religious festival, establish or maintain any eating house, restaurant or tea or coffee boutique except under the authority of a special licence issued in that behalf by the Chairman, and the provisions of by-laws 4, 5 and 6 of these by-laws shall be applicable to every holder of such a licence, and to the eating-house, restaurant or tea or coffee boutique, as the case may be, in respect of which such licence has been issued. Provided, however, that such licence shall not be necessary in the case of any eating house, restaurant or tea or coffee boutique for which a licence has been issued under by-law 1 in respect of the year in which such festival is held.”

11. The by-laws relating to the tax on vehicles and animals published in *Gazette* No. 8,655 of August 23, 1940, are hereby amended in so far as they relate to the Rambodagalla village area by the insertion, immediately after by-law 7, of the following new by-law:—

“7A It shall be lawful for the Chairman, or the Revenue Overseer or any other officer authorized by the Chairman in writing, to stop and detain any vehicle proceeding on any road or path, for the purpose of inspecting the plate which is required by by-law 7 to be affixed to that vehicle, and the driver or person in charge of any such vehicle shall, on being requested by the Chairman, Revenue Overseer or such authorized officer to do so, stop the vehicle and permit and assist the Chairman, Revenue Overseer or the authorized officer to inspect such plate”

(v) Keeping a cattle shed or gala”; and

(2) by the addition, in paragraph (2) thereof, immediately after the item “(o) Manufacture of matches” of the following:—

- “(p) Keeping a smithy
(q) Manufacture of jewellery.
(r) Keeping a kerosene oil depot
(s) Keeping a rice huller.
(t) Keeping a timber or firewood depot.
(u) Manufacture of coconut oil by chekku
(v) Keeping a printing press.
(w) Keeping a toddy collecting station.
(x) Manufacturing tea.”

- (c) Any trade in which machinery driven by oil or other fuel or steam or electricity is used.
- (d) Extracting oil by apparatus.
- (e) Quarrying cabook, gravel or metal
- (f) Manufacturing desiccated coconut.
- (g) Curing or storing plumbago.
- (h) Digging for coral stones by opening a pit
- (i) Keeping a rice mill.
- (j) Manufacturing coconut oil by machinery.
- (k) Keeping a timber or firewood depot.
- (l) Manufacturing or storing fibre.
- (m) Storing cotton wool.
- (n) Keeping a kerosene oil depot.
- (o) Keeping a printing press.
- (p) Manufacturing cigars, cigarettes or beedies.
