**IMPORT CONTROL NOTICE No. 24/54**

**Importation of Boots and Shoes of Rubber**

THE attention of importers is drawn to the notification dated October 14, 1954, published in *Gazette* No. 10,725 of October 16, 1954, whereby Boots and Shoes made wholly or partially of rubber have been brought under licence from all sources. This does not include leather footwear with rubber soles.

2. Importers are requested to forward to this office within 10 days from the date of this notice, a statement of their outstanding orders which have been confirmed and cannot be cancelled. The necessary documents should be annexed for information and return. No further orders should be placed until a licence has been obtained.

**IMPORT CONTROL NOTICE No. 25/54**

THE attention of importers is drawn to the Notification dated October 14, 1954, published in *Gazette* No. 10,725 of October 16, 1954

The items " 16B-Red onions ", " 22a any product of rice " and " 2B Grain Wheat " are included in the schedule to the Food Supplies Ordinance, No. 30 of 1947 and can only be imported by Government

" 17a Jaggery produced in and shipped from India and Pakistan " is under Open General Licence No. 1 and can only be imported from these two sources without an individual import licence

The item " 144a Bon-bais (crackers) " has now been included in Open General Licence No. 1, and can be imported from the U. K. and other Open General Licence No. 1 sources without an individual import licence.
