PANALUWA FIRING RANGE

All that area of land situated in the villages of Panaluwa, Hanwella Pahala, Tunnane and Mawagagama in Meda Pattuwa of Hewagam Korale, Colombo District, Western Province, and bounded as follows—

North: By a line drawn from the landmark on the western boundary of lot 10 in P. Plan No. S. 609 W. P. about 2½ chains south-east of the point where the Village Committee path leading to the Colombo-Avissawella main road meets the right bank of Pusweli Oya, eastwards along a straight line through the said lot 10 to the landmark on the western boundary of lot 5134 (T. P. 319882) in P. Plan No. 15378 W. P. about 3½ chains north of the southern-most corner of the said lot 5134 (T. P. 319882); thence southwards along the western boundaries of lots 5134 (T. P. 319882) and 5133 (T. P. 319890) in P. Plan No. 15378 W. P. and the western boundary of lot 1 (Diagram No. O 4704) in P. Plan No. A 1240 W. P. to the landmark at the south-western corner of the said lot 1 (Diagram No. O 4704); thence north-eastwards along the southern boundary of the said lot 1 (Diagram No. O 4704) and the eastern boundary of lot 5133 (T. P. 319890) in P. Plan No. 15378 W. P. to the landmark on the northern boundary of lot 2 in P. Plan No. S. 608 W. P. at the southern-most corner of lot 5135 (T. P. 319888) in P. Plan No. 15378 W. P.; thence north-eastwards and south-eastwards along the northern boundary of lot 2 in P. Plan No. S. 608 W. P. to the north-western corner of lot 1 (T. P. 370072) in P. Plan No. 18220 W. P.; thence southwards, eastwards and north-westwards along the western, southern and eastern boundaries of the said lot 1 (T. P. 370072) in P. Plan No. 18220 W. P. to the north-eastern corner of the said lot 1 (T. P. 370072); thence eastwards along the northern boundary of lot 3 in P. Plan No. S. 608 W. P. to the landmark at the north-eastern corner of the said lot 3; thence eastwards along a straight line across lot 17 (reservation for path) in P. Plan No. A. 201 W. P. to the landmark on the western boundary of lot 14 in P. Plan No. A. 3592 W. P.; thence south-eastwards along the western boundary of the said lot 14 to the landmark at the north-western corner of lot 16 in P. Plan No. A. 3592 W. P.; thence eastwards along the northern boundary of the said lot 16 to the landmark at its north-eastern corner.

2. Order Under Section 3

East : By a line drawn from the last-mentioned point south-eastwards along the eastern boundary of lot 16 in P. Plan No. A. 3592 W. P. to the landmark at the south-eastern corner of the said lot 16; thence southwards along a straight line across lot 2 (reservation for foot path) in P. Plan No. 18985 W. P. to the landmark on the northern boundary of lot 1 (T. P. 391747) in P. Plan No. 18985 W. P.; thence westwards along the northern boundary of the said lot 1 (T. P. 391747) to the landmark at its north-western corner; thence southwards and eastwards along the western and southern boundaries of the said lot 1 T. P. (391747) to the landmark at its south-eastern corner; thence southwards and south-westwards along the eastern and southern boundaries of lot 5 and the southern boundary of lot 6 in P. Plan No. S. 608 W. P. to the landmark at the southern-most corner of the said lot 6; thence southwards along the eastern boundary of lot 2 in P. Plan No. S. 608 W. P. to the northern boundary of the foot path leading to the main road; thence southwards along a straight line across the said foot path to the northern boundary of lot 8 in P. Plan No. S. 608 W. P.; thence south-eastwards and north-eastwards along the northern boundary of the said lot 8 till it meets the landmark at the south-western corner of lot 1 in P. Plan No. 20315 W. P.; thence due southwards along a straight line through the said lot 8 and across the Godawela Ela to its left bank; thence south-eastwards, eastwards and southwards along the left bank of the said Godawela Ela to the landmark on the eastern boundary of lot 10 in P. Plan No. S. 608 W. P. at the north-western corner of Sondaralyadda claimed by D Ukkuwa and others; thence southwards and westwards along the eastern and southern boundaries of the said lot 10 to the landmark on the said southern boundary about $4\frac{1}{2}$ chains south-east of the landmark at the north-western corner of lot 1 in P. Plan No. 19414; thence south-westwards along a straight line through the said lot 1 to the landmark on the southern boundary of the said lot 10 about $3\frac{1}{2}$ chains north-west of the landmark at the south-western corner of the said lot 1; thence southwards and eastwards along the southern boundary of the said

lot 10 to the landmark at the south-eastern corner of the said lot 10; thence south-westwards along the southern boundaries of lots 10 and 13 in P. Plan No. S. 608 and crossing Messenkeneniya Ela to the landmark on the south-western corner of the said lot 13; thence south-westwards along a straight line through lot 1 in P. Plan No. S. 607 W. P. and across Puseeli Oya and through lot 12 in P. Plan No. S. 614 W. P. to the landmark at the north-eastern corner of lot 5 in P. Plan No. A. 3100 W. P.; thence south-westwards, south-eastwards and again south-westwards along the eastern boundaries of lots 5, 19 (road) and 18 and southern boundaries of lots 20 and 22 in P. Plan No. A. 3100 W. P. to the landmark at the south-western corner of the said lot 22; thence south-eastwards along the eastern boundary of lot 23 in the said plan to the landmark on the said boundary at the southern-most point of lot 30 in P. Plan No. S. 614.

South : By a line drawn from the last-mentioned point south-westwards and westwards along the eastern and southern boundaries of lot 23 in P. Plan No. A. 3100 to the landmark at the south-western corner of the said lot 23.

West : By a line drawn from the last-mentioned point northwards, eastwards and again northwards along the western boundaries of lots 23, 19 (road), 17, 16, 14 (Reservation for a road) and 10 and western boundary of lot 9 P. Plan No. A. 3100 W. P. to the northern-most point of the said lot 9; thence north-westwards, northwards, south-westwards and westwards along the southern boundaries of lots 9 and 8 in P. Plan No. S. 614 W. P. to the landmark at the south-western corner of the said lot 8; thence north-eastwards and northwards along the western boundaries of lots 8 and 4 in P. Plan No. S. 614 W. P. to the landmark at the north-eastern corner of lot 3 in the said plan; thence northwards along a straight line through lot 4 in P. Plan No. S. 614 W. P. and across Pusweli Oya and through lot 13 in P. Plan No. S. 609 to the landmark on the southern boundary of lot 10 in P. Plan No. S. 609 about 4 chains east of the landmark at the south-western corner of the said lot 10, thence westwards and north-westwards along the western boundary of the said lot 10 to the starting point of the northern limit of the area
