# D. & E. A. No. D. 6/Sub-Leg THE FIRING BANGES AND MILITARY TRAINING ACT, No. 24 OF 1951

## Order under Section 2

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by section 2 of the Firing Ranges and Military Training Act, No. 24 of 1951, as amended by the Order under section 2 of the Assignment of Ministers' Functions (Consequential Provisions) Act, No. 29 of 1953, published in Gazette No. 10,593 of October 2, 1953, I, John Lionel Kotelawala, Minister of Defence and External Affairs, do by this Order, with the concurrence of the Minister of Lands and Land Development, establish a firing range on Crown land at Panaluwa in the Meda Pattu in Hewagam Korale in the Colombo District (to be known as the Panaluwa Firing Range), and the boundaries of that firing range shall be those specified in the Schedule hereto.
