**First Report of the Housing Loans Board for the
Period Ending on September 30, 1951**

GENERAL

The Housing Loans Board was established by the Housing Loans Act, No. 26 of 1949, with the general object of lending money in accordance with the Act for the purpose of promoting and assisting the execution of housing schemes approved by the Board.

2. The Housing Loans (Amendment) Act, No. 22 of 1951, permitted of applications for loans being considered by the Board from individuals for the erection of houses for their residence. It also permitted of consideration of applications from local authorities for loans for the purpose of the execution of middle-class housing schemes. The enabling regulations in this connection were not finalized during the period under review.

3. The members of the Board are—

The Secretary to the Treasury (Chairman ex-officio) ;
The Commissioner of Local Government ;
The Solicitor-General ;
The Government Town Planner ;
The Director of Public Works ; and
The Registrar of Co-operative Societies.

The preliminary meeting of the Board was held on October 17, 1949. Up to the year ending on September 30, 1950, five meetings of the Board were held. The arrangements that were necessary for the commencement of the business of the Board were discussed at these meetings and proposals were in this connection submitted to the Ministry of Health and Local Government by way of draft subsidiary legislation. In April, 1950, the Housing Loans Regulations, 1950, were published laying down the definition of a housing scheme, the prescribed form for application, the rates of interest, &c.

4. During the year ended September, 1951, nine meetings of the Board were held. By October, 1950, the final regulations enabling the actual grant of loans were published. The first two loans for two housing schemes were also sanctioned in the same month.

APPLICATIONS FOR LOANS

5. At the end of September, 1951, the Board had received 113 applications for loans for the execution of housing schemes. After the necessary examination, 13 of these applications were favourably considered, the total amount of loan sanctioned thereon being Rs. 1,414,650. These involved 13 housing schemes consisting of 56 middle-class houses. The loans were payable in instalments at different stages of progress of building operations. As regards the remaining 100 applications the position at September 30, 1951, was as follows :—

6. As the law originally stood, a proposed housing scheme for consideration should have consisted of at least three houses or three units of residential accommodation. Each house or unit of residential accommodation constituting a scheme should have consisted of at least two living rooms with a total floor area of not less than 240 sq. ft. and a kitchen, bath and lavatory ; it should also not have exceeded in the opinion of the Board an estimated monthly rental of Rs. 200. An amending Regulation was published in July, 1951, reducing the minimum number of houses or units of residential accommodation that constituted a housing scheme to two.

7. Applications for loans for erection of single houses are not dealt with in this report as they were considered after the period under review.

From August 1, 1951, a full-time Secretary was appointed.

ACCOUNTS

9. The accounts for the period of April 1, 1950, to September 30, 1950, and October 1, 1950, to September 30, 1951, are annexed hereto.

10. *Period April 1, 1950, to September 30, 1954.*—In terms of section 5 of the Act, the Housing Loans Fund was constituted with a capital of Rs. 5 millions voted as a grant by a resolution of the House of Representatives Operations on the Fund commenced on April 1, 1950. The entire grant from the Government was allowed to remain in deposit with the Treasury to be drawn upon as and when required.

11. The working expenses of the Board for the period April 1, 1950, to September 30, 1950, amounted to Rs. 3,324.84. As would be seen from the accounts annexed hereto, these expenses may fairly be regarded as preliminary expenses incurred in connection with the setting up of the necessary administrative machinery. By about the end of 1951-52 it should be possible for the Board to meet all its working expenses from the revenue derived by way of interest on loans granted.

12. *Period October 1, 1950, to September 30, 1951.*—The working expenses of this period amounted to Rs. 8,329.83 and were met from the Board's funds. During this period as stated above the total amount of loans sanctioned was Rs. 1,414,650, which was payable at different stages of building operations. Instalments of loans actually paid on execution of mortgage bonds and satisfactory progress of building operations amounted to Rs. 337,825.

Interest which accrued on loans paid during the year amounted to Rs. 3,326.45.

There was a net loss of Rs. 5,037.63 for the year ending on September 30, 1951. It is expected that this loss together with the loss of Rs. 3,324.82 for the previous year will be met by the profits which will accrue during the year ending on September 30, 1952.

**Report of the Auditor-General on the Accounts of the Housing Loans Board for the two years
1949-50 and 1950-51**

COMMENCEMENT OF BUSINESS

Although the Housing Loans Act, No. 26 of 1949, which established the Housing Loans Board, came into effect on June 6, 1949, it was only in October, 1950, that regulations to enable the grant of loans were published. During the year ended September 30, 1950, which was the first year of business, no loans could therefore be granted. In the second year, however, the Board commenced granting loans for execution of housing schemes. This report accordingly covers the accounts of the two years 1949-50 and 1950-51 and is furnished in accordance with Section 50 of the Act.

ACCOUNTING REGULATIONS

2. Section 46 of the Housing Loans Act requires that the Board shall cause its accounts to be kept in such form and in such manner as may be prescribed. No regulations have, however, been framed so far and I have been informed that it is not intended to frame any regulations under this section, as in the opinion of the Board it is not absolutely necessary to prescribe by regulation the manner in which the accounts should be kept.

PROFIT AND LOSS ACCOUNT

3. The Profit and Loss Account, as prepared by the Board, discloses a loss of Rs. 3,324.82 for the year ended September 30, 1950, and of Rs. 5,037.63 for the year ended September 30, 1951. In arriving at these losses, the salaries and allowances of the Staff of the Board, have been charged as expenses of the Housing Loans Fund, contrary to the provisions of Section 41 (2) of the Act, which says that such Salaries and Allowances "shall be paid out of the Consolidated Fund from moneys provided by Parliament for the purpose". In reply to my enquiry regarding the reasons for the omission to follow the procedure laid down in the Act, the Chairman of the Housing Loans Board has stated that in paragraph 2 of the details of Supplementary Estimate No. 1 of 1949-50 submitted to Parliament for the grant of Rs. 5,000,000 to the Housing Loans Board for appropriation to the Housing Loans Fund under Section 5 (2) (a) of the Act, it had been made clear that "the Housing Loans Fund was intended to meet *inter alia* the Salaries and Allowances of the Staff of the Board". I regret I am unable to agree that an explanatory note appended to a Supplementary Estimate can be regarded as over-riding a specific provision contained in the Housing Loans Act and I am, therefore, not in a position to certify that the Profit and Loss Accounts for the two years under review disclose the true operating results.

FEES ON LOAN APPLICATIONS

4. In terms of Rules framed by the Minister under Section 55 of the Housing Loans Act, every applicant for a loan should make an initial deposit for meeting all fees incurred in respect of valuation of property offered as security, the examination of title, the execution of bonds, &c. The amounts paid out of such deposits are shown as "contra" items in the P. and L. Account to make the account informative and the unexpended balance of such deposits is exhibited as a liability in the Balance Sheet. It is, however, observed that in the details of the Supplementary Estimate referred to in the preceding paragraph it had also been stated that the Housing Loans Fund was intended to meet "the fees for the examination of title of property submitted as security for loans and other incidental expenses". Unlike what was done in regard to Staff Salaries, the Board very correctly ignored this explanatory note, which was in conflict with the provisions of the rules framed under the Act.

GOVERNMENT GRANT

5. A sum of Rs. 5,000,000 was provided by Supplementary Estimate in 1949-50 as grant to Housing Loans Board. Of this a sum of Rs. 5,000 was received by the Board during 1949-50 and the balance was transferred to a deposit account in the Treasury Books in April, 1950, in which account it remained without earning any interest till January, 1952. The Chairman, Housing Loans Board, has explained to me that "although his Board was desirous of withdrawing the entire sum of Rs. 5,000,000 from the Treasury and investing such portion of it as was not immediately required in fixed deposits, &c., the Treasury was not in a position to release the amount until January, 1952".

**Observations of the Ministry of Industries, Housing and Social Services on the Report of the
Auditor-General**

1. *Payment of salaries and allowances of staff of the Housing Loans Board from the Housing Loans Fund.*—The Attorney-General agrees with the opinion of the Auditor-General that payment of salaries and allowances of the staff of the Housing Loans Board from the Housing Loans Fund constitutes a violation of the provisions of Section 5 (2) (a) of the Housing Loans Act, No. 26 of 1949.

Suitable action is being taken in regard to this matter.

2. *Regulations for keeping of accounts.*—Regulations in terms of Section 46 of the Housing Loans Act, No. 26 of 1949, are being drafted and will shortly be presented to Parliament.
