GENERAL CONDITIONS APPLICABLE TO APPOINTMENTS TO POSTS IN THE PUBLIC SERVICE ADVERTISED IN THE "CEYLON GOVERNMENT GAZETTE"

Allowances.—Unless otherwise stated, Rent Allowance, temporary Cost of Living Allowance and temporary Special Living Allowance are payable according to Government Regulations.

Conditions of Service.—Appointments will be subject to the Public Service Commission Rules, the Financial Regulations, the Regulations of the Manual of Procedure, Departmental Orders or Regulations, and any other orders or regulations issued from time to time by the Government.

Terms of Engagement.—(i) In the case of appointments to the non-pensionable establishment (excluding those on daily rates of pay) appointees will be required to contribute 5 per cent. of their salary to the Public Service Provident Fund, and they will be allowed to contribute, at their option, a further 5 per cent. War Service Concession.—Provided they are qualified in all other respects, ex-Servicemen of Her Majesty's Fighting Forces and full-time members of the Auxiliary Fire, Air Raid Precautions and Civil Defence Services (excluding those who had left these Services of their own accord), will be allowed to deduct periods of such service commencing from September 3, 1939, at the earliest, and up to December 31, 1949, at the latest, from their ages for purposes of eligibility alone, provided that they joined the Forces before August 15, 1945, and that such service was satisfactory and continuous.

Other Requirements.—(i) Applications from officers of the Public Service, who are qualified, must be forwarded through the Heads of their respective Departments. In the case of applications from officers holding permanent posts in the Public Service, the Heads of the Departments concerned should, in forwarding the applications, state whether or not they are prepared to release the applicants (if selected) in accordance with Administrative Regulation 109 of the Manual of Procedure.

Award of Colombo Plan Fellowships in T. B. Work

APPLICATIONS are invited from Medical Officers of the Department of Health for the award of the under-mentioned fellowships under the Colombo Plan in the United Kingdom. The acceptance of the selected candidates for training is subject to the approval of the Colombo Plan authorities in the U. K.

2. The applicants should be registered with the General Medical Council in U. K. or produce written assurance from the General Medical Council in U. K. that the experience they have gained will entitle them for either temporary or full registration.

(The condition of registration is that after the candidate becomes registrable in Ceylon, he should have done a full years House Appointments at approved Hospitals in Medicine, Surgery and Midwifery.)

- 1. Visiting Physician/Paediatrician . 1 fellowship.
 2. Radiologist 1 fellowship.
