#### GENERAL CONDITIONS APPLICABLE TO APPOINTMENTS TO POSTS IN THE PUBLIC SERVICE ADVERTISED IN THE "CEYLON GOVERNMENT GAZETTE"

**Allowances.**—Unless otherwise stated, Rent Allowance, temporary Cost of Living Allowance and temporary Special Living Allowance are payable according to Government Regulations.

**Conditions of Service.**—Appointments will be subject to the Public Service Commission Rules, the Financial Regulations, the Regulations of the Manual of Procedure, Departmental Orders or Regulations, and any other orders or regulations issued from time to time by the Government.

**Terms of Engagement.**—(i) In the case of appointments to the non-pensionable establishment (excluding those on daily rates of pay) appointees will be required to contribute 5 per cent. of their salary to the Public Service Provident Fund, and they will be allowed to contribute, at their option, a further 5 per cent. The Government contribution, in either case, will be equal to 7½ per cent. of the salary paid in at the close of each financial year.

(ii) Appointees may be required to furnish security in terms of the Public Officers' (Security) Ordinance, if so required by the Head of their Department.

(iii) Appointees other than those already in the Public Service will be required to pass a medical examination by a Government Medical Officer as to their physical fitness to serve in any part of the Island.

**Qualifications required.**—Every applicant must furnish satisfactory proof that he is a Ceylonese. A "Ceylonese" is a citizen of Ceylon by descent or by registration.

**War Service Concession.**—Provided they are qualified in all other respects, ex-Servicemen of Her Majesty's Fighting Forces and full-time members of the Auxiliary Fire, Air Raid Precautions

and Civil Defence Services (excluding those who had left these Services of their own accord), will be allowed to deduct periods of such service commencing from September 3, 1939, at the earliest, and up to December 31, 1949, at the latest, from their ages for purposes of eligibility alone, provided that they joined the Forces before August 15, 1945, and that such service was satisfactory and continuous.

**Other Requirements.**—(i) Applications from officers of the Public Service, who are qualified, must be forwarded through the Heads of their respective Departments. In the case of applications from officers holding permanent posts in the Public Service, the Heads of the Departments concerned should, in forwarding the applications, state whether or not they are prepared to release the applicants (if selected) in accordance with Administrative Regulation 109 of the Manual of Procedure.

(ii) Candidates may be required to present themselves for interview at an appointed time and place. No travelling or other expenses will be paid in this connection.

(iii) Anyone desiring to recommend a candidate should do so by giving a testimonial. Any form of canvassing or attempt to influence the selection of a candidate will disqualify such candidate.

(iv) Any statement in the application which is found to be incorrect will render the applicant liable to disqualification if the inaccuracy is discovered before the selection, and to dismissal if discovered after the selection.

**TRAINING FACILITIES IN FARM ACCOUNTING AND COSTING OF FARM OPERATIONS UNDER THE COLOMBO PLAN TECHNICAL CO-OPERATION SCHEME**

APPLICATIONS are invited from members of the Accountants' Service for the award of training facilities for the study of farm accounting methods, costing of farm operations, &c, in the United Kingdom. The training will be for a period of one year.

Applications, which should be made on a special form obtainable from this office, must reach me on or before the following dates:—

- (a) *Local applications*—January 14, 1955.
- (b) *Overseas applications*—January 21, 1955.

2. *Terms of Award.*—The United Kingdom Government will meet the transport and other approved expenses normally attached to these awards.

3. *Qualifications required.*—Every applicant must furnish satisfactory proof that he—

- (a) is not more than 45 years of age on January 14, 1955.
- (b) is of excellent moral character and physically sound.

4. *Agreements and Security.*—The selected candidate will have—

- (a) to enter into an agreement with the Government of Ceylon undertaking among other things to follow and complete satisfactorily the prescribed course of training and to serve the Government, if so required, for a period of not less than 5 years (to be decided by Government) on the satisfactory completion of the course of training.
- (b) to enter into a personal bond in a sum covering the full costs of the traineeship as indemnity in the event of his failure to comply with the terms and conditions in the agreement.

5 The selected candidate will be required to pass a medical examination by a Medical Board appointed by Government as to his physical and mental fitness to undergo a course of training in the country in which it is to be undertaken. A high degree of physical and mental health is required.

6. Applications or any other communication relating to this award must be addressed to the Secretary, Public Service Commission, and not personally to any officer in this Department.

7. Award of training facilities by the Colombo Plan Technical Co-operation is subject to the acceptance of the nomination by the Council for Colombo Plan Technical Co-operation in south and south-east Asia.

**DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH**

**Selection of Candidates for Admission to the Nurses' Training School**

APPLICATIONS are invited from women candidates (married or unmarried) for selection as Pupil Nurses at the Nurses' Training Schools.

2. *Qualifications required.*—Every applicant must furnish satisfactory proof that she—

- (a) is not less than 17 and not more than 25 years of age on December 31, 1954, except in the case of Emergency Nurses and female employees in the Department, V. A. D. Nurses and those who were in the service, in whose case the maximum age limit will be 32;
- (b) has passed the Senior School Certificate (English) or Senior Domestic Science Certificate or equivalent or higher examination;
- (c) has a minimum height of 4 feet 8 inches;
- (d) is of good character and of sound constitution and is physically fit to serve in any part of the Island.

3. *Method of Application.*—

- (a) Applications must be made on the specimen form appended below and should be sent under registered cover addressed to "The Director of Health Services, P. O. Box 500, Colombo", and should be marked "Application for Selection as Pupil Nurses", on the left-hand corner.
- (b) Applications should not be addressed personally to the undersigned or to any officer in the Department, nor should they be handed to any officer in this office.
- (c) Originals of certificates or documents should not be attached to the application. Only copies should be sent and these will not be returned. Originals, if forwarded, will not be returned.
- (d) The application should be accompanied by—
  - (i) Copy of birth certificate (Baptismal certificate or certificate issued for the purpose of the Code of Regulations for Assisted Schools will not be accepted.)
  - (ii) Copies of educational certificates.
  - (iii) Copies of 2 certificates of character, one of which must be from the Principal of the School or College which the candidate last attended.

4. *Medical Examination.*—Selected candidates will be required to undergo a medical examination as to physical fitness to serve as a nurse in any part of the Island. No candidate will be selected who does not pass the medical examination.

5. *Course of Training at the Nurses' Training School*—

- (a) The course of training will be for a period of 3 years. The syllabus and scheme of examination will be supplied to eligible candidates.
- (b) Pupils whose work and conduct are found unsatisfactory at any time during the period of training will be discontinued.
- (c) Free quarters will be provided during the period of training.

6. *Salary Scale, Allowances and Conditions of Service*.—

O. & M. OFFICERS

APPLICATIONS are invited from members of the Public Service holding pensionable appointments for three vacancies for Organisation and Methods Officers in the Organisation and Methods Division of the Treasury. Initially, officers will be selected for trial for a period of six months and if they prove to be suitable, they will be retained on O & M. work for about three years. If not, they will be permitted to resume the duties of their previous posts without suffering loss of seniority or any prospects in the Service to which they belong. At the end of the period of three years, their position will be reviewed and they may continue to serve in the Division for a longer period. An O. & M. Officer will be released at any time on reasonable notice.

2. Selected officers will be seconded for service in the O. & M. Division. Initially, they will be expected to undergo training on O. & M. work as well as in staff training. They will be required to do O. & M. work or training work according to the exigencies of the Department.

3. *Qualifications*—Applicants must—

- (a) be under 42 years of age on January 7, 1955,
- (b) have served Government for at least seven years in administrative or executive posts; or ten years in the Clerical Service or analogous grades;
- (c) draw a salary of not less than Rs. 2,640 per annum on December 1, 1954.

4. *Salary*—Selected officers other than those in the Clerical Service or analogous grades will not be eligible for any additional emoluments while under secondment. Officers in the Clerical Service or analogous grades will be paid, in addition to their substantive scale, an allowance of Rs 480 per annum rising to Rs. 1,440 per annum by increments of Rs. 240 per annum.

5. Preference will be given to those who have displayed organisational ability in their work or have had considerable experience in administrative work.

**INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES FOR  
CADETSHIPS PRIOR TO COMMISSIONING  
AS SECOND LIEUTENANTS IN THE ARMY**

1. Four vacancies are now offered for Cadetships prior to commissioning in the rank of Second Lieutenant in the Army.

2. Applicants for Cadetships will be required to fulfil the conditions set out in paragraph 4 below. A preliminary selection will be made from applications received from those who fulfil these conditions, and a final selection will be made after interview of these selected candidates by a Selection Board appointed by the Minister of Defence.

3. The following is the procedure which will be adopted and the rules which will apply in respect of those candidates who are selected for the existing vacancies :—

- (a) Candidates will be enlisted as Army cadets on a normal regular engagement for a period of five years with the colours and seven years with the Reserve
- (b) On enlistment, selected candidates will be required to undergo such training in Ceylon as may be prescribed by the Commander of the Army.
- (c) On successful completion of the training referred to in para (b) above, cadets will be sent at Government expense to the United Kingdom where they will undergo a short period of training with the British Army, commencing in June, 1955, before being admitted to the Royal Military Academy, Sandhurst, for a course of training of 18 months, commencing in September, 1955.
- (d) During the period of training at Sandhurst, all tuition and maintenance fees for which will be paid by the Ceylon Government, the status of cadets will be that of other ranks and they will be subject to Military Law. Their basic rate of pay while under training in the United Kingdom will be that of a One Star soldier of the British Army (i.e., 8 shillings per diem) on first enlistment and that of a Three Star soldier of the British Army (i.e., 9sh 6d. per diem) on completion of 12 months' service. No cost of living allowance is payable. All expenses such as pocket money, maintenance during compulsory leave periods between terms at Sandhurst, the cost of civilian clothes which may be worn when off duty, etc., will be the responsibility of the parents or guardian of the individual cadet. Such expenses should be about Rs. 2,000 per annum for the period during which the cadet is away from Ceylon. However, they will be entitled to 3sh. 4d. per diem as ration allowance during compulsory leave periods (i.e., periods of non-attachment to a Mess).
- (e) (i) In the event of a cadet voluntarily terminating his candidature for a commission during his course at Sandhurst, the parent or guardian will be required to refund to the Ceylon Government all expenses incurred up to that time by the Ceylon Government on account of such cadet. Such cadet will also be required to return to Ceylon at his own expense.
- (ii) If at any time during his course, a cadet is reported on by the authorities at Sandhurst as being unsuitable, for reasons of misconduct, or due to causes

within his own control, for the issue of a commission, his parents or guardian will be required to refund to the Ceylon Government all expenses incurred on his account by the Ceylon Government.

- (f) Parents or guardians will sign declarations as given in paragraph 10 below in respect of sub-paragraphs (d) and (e) above and forward them together with the application. Parents or guardians of selected candidates will be required to enter into a Bond substantially in this form with the Ceylon Government prior to the appointment of these candidates.
- (g) After successful completion of the period of training at Sandhurst, cadets will return to Ceylon at Government expense and will thereupon be commissioned as Second Lieutenants in an arm of the Service of the Army according to their aptitude and the needs of the Army at that time. On appointments to commissions cadets will be discharged from the Regular Army engagement into which they entered as "Other Ranks". Officers will be expected to serve in the Army for a minimum period of 5 years after commissioning. The prospects and conditions of pay and service for officers of the Army are as published in the *Government Gazette* and reproduced in the Press.

4. The conditions under which candidates may be accepted for cadetships are as follows :—

- (a) *Nationality*.—Candidates must be citizens of Ceylon.
- (b) *Age*.—Candidates must be not less than 19 years and not more than 21 years of age on February 7, 1955.
- (c) *Education*.—Candidates must have passed the Senior School Certificate Examination (English). Preference in selection will be given to those candidates who have passed such examination with not less than five credits (including English, Physics and Mathematics) and a pass in Sinhalese or Tamil.
- (d) *Status*.—A candidate must be unmarried. No cadet will be permitted to marry while at the Royal Military Academy, Sandhurst.
- (e) *Medical Standard*.—A candidate must conform to the required medical standard. All candidates selected for final interview by the Selection Board will be medically examined under Ceylon Army arrangements at the time of the interview.

5. Applications for cadetships will be submitted in writing on a copy of the form given in paragraph 8 below, and will be forwarded to the Army Commander, P O Box 553, Colombo, to reach there not later than January 9, 1955. The envelope in which the application is forwarded will be marked "APPLICATION FOR ARMY CADETS".

6. Applications will be accompanied by two certificates of character, one of which shall be originated by a responsible person of mature age who has known the applicant for the past one year in private life, and the other from the Principal of the last school attended.

7. Those candidates who are selected for interview by the Selection Board will be informed in writing of the place, time and date of such interview. Interviews will take place in Colombo. No travelling or other expenses will be paid by the Ceylon Government in this respect.

The candidates who are not selected for interview by the Selection Board will be so informed.

The houses have tiled roofs and cement rendered floors; they consist of a verandah, two rooms, a kitchen and a water seal lavatory. Drinking water will be available from stand pipes; bathing facilities will be provided in the form of centrally situated bathing wells. Each house will be supplied with electricity.

3. The housing scheme is within half a mile of the Colombo-Negombo Road and approximately two miles of the Colombo-Kandy Road. It adjoins the Colombo-Kandy Railway line, where a new Railway halting place will be provided for the convenience of residents. The Kiribathgoda Hospital is within two miles of the site. School facilities are available in the neighbourhood. The scheme will eventually also have shops and a Community Centre.

4. The rentals for the houses will be as follows:—

- (a) *With brick or cabook walls.*—Rs. 23 50 per mensem if repayment is over 20 years. Rs. 19 per mensem if repayment is over 25 years.
- (b) *With stabilized earth walls.*—Rs. 21 per mensem if repayment is over 20 years. Rs. 17 per mensem if repayment is over 25 years.

Applicants are required to state whether they are prepared to make payment over 20 years or over 25 years. Applicants who are prepared to pay over lesser periods than 20 years should indicate this in their applications.

5. Legal ownership will be transferred to the occupant only after the entirety of the value of the house has been repaid. If at any stage of tenancy the occupant is able to pay off the entire amount outstanding in a lump sum, ownership will be transferred on such payment. Occupants will, however, be required to maintain the houses themselves and to pay rates, taxes and electricity and other dues themselves from the date on which they enter into occupation; one of the conditions of the agreement will be that a tenant can be evicted for unsatisfactory maintenance of the premises.

6. The selection of occupants will be made by the Commissioner for National Housing. Any attempt at canvassing will disqualify the applicants. Co-operative Societies, Building Societies and other similar organisations may, if they wish send applications duly completed and signed by their members in a single batch, with a request for allotment of houses in a compact block.

7. Applications must be forwarded on forms which are available at all Post Offices within the Colombo Municipal area. They should be addressed to the Commissioner for National Housing, Senate Square, Fort, Colombo 1, and should reach him not later than 12 noon on Saturday, January 8, 1955. Envelopes should be clearly marked "APPLICATIONS FOR GONGITOTA HOUSING SCHEME".
