Abstract.—The nature of the invention can be ascertained from claims 1, 2 and 3 which read as follows —

1 A method of removing tarnish from silver articles in which tarnished silver articles are treated with an aqueous solution including an acid which is stronger than hydrosulphuric acid but is not such as will, in aqueous solution attack silver to any material extent and a soluble compound capable of forming a soluble complex with silver ions which complex gives rise to substantially no silver ions in aqueous solution, said soluble compound fulfilling both of the tests hereinbefore specified

2 A method as claimed in claim 1 in which the acid is one or more of the following — sulphuric, hydrochloric, phosphoric, acetic, citric and tartaric acids

3 A method as claimed in claims 1 or 2 in which the aqueous detarnishing solution contains from 0.3—10% of acid
