





A rotary valve for pipe-lines, comprising a valve case, a valve member proper therein, and a packing arrangement between the valve member and case which packing arrangement can be at least partially dismantled per se, characterized by the provision between the valve member and case of an auxiliary or secondary packing arrangement which can be brought into operation to enable the first mentioned packing arrangement to be dismantled, without either draining the upstream pipe-line or providing a separate auxiliary closure valve.
