THE following specifications have been accepted. —  
No 4,075 of January 6, 1954 (Registration of British Patent No 679,612 of November 1, 1946, under Section 46 of the Ordinance)

*Svit, narodni podnik (formerly Bata A. G)*

"Improvements relating to the manufacture of footwear of rubber or the like"

*Abstract*—This invention relates to the manufacture of footwear. An object of the present invention is to eliminate the disadvantages of the known presses for the pressing of the shoe soles made of rubber and the like and the simultaneous vulcanisation of the soles to the finished uppers. According to the invention this is achieved by providing a novel arrangement allowing the use of much lighter and simpler press components and characterised in that the pressures necessary for the pressing operation acting in two directions at right angles to each other are produced by means of a loop adapted to be moved by screw-threaded spindles and equipped with a press plunger and with two arms linked in toggle lever fashion to holding pieces forming each a parallelogram link system with associated supporting rods.

"Improvements in or relating to washing machines"

*Abstract*—This invention relates to washing machines.

The present invention comprises a container for washing liquid, a rotary agitator mounted in a side wall of the container where normally it will be submerged in the washing liquid and a disc the circumferential edge of which lies throughout its circumference close to the side wall of the container or to a part thereon to prevent articles being washed entering the space behind the agitator. The agitator is rotated continuously by suitable driving apparatus.
