"Process of obtaining water white oil from fresh coconut meat"

Abstract.—The invention relates to a purely mechanical process of obtaining water white oil from fresh coconut meat.

The nature of the invention can be ascertained from claims 1 and 2 which read as follows:—

1. A process of obtaining water white oil from fresh coconut meat purely by mechanical means consisting in pressing the fresh coconut meat, controlling temperature of the cream obtained by pressing to inhibit growth of bacteria, agitating and heating of coconut cream previous to separation of coconut oil and then filtering and pasteurizing under vacuum of the finished product.

2. A process of obtaining water white oil from fresh coconut meat as claimed in claim 1 which consists in pressing the coconut meat, controlling the temperature of the coconut cream obtained by pressing such as to inhibit growth of bacteria, then heating the cream while being agitated for easy separation of the coconut oil, filtering same and then subjecting the filtrate to mechanical separator to separate the concentrated coconut oil from its other components and preferably finally passing the oil through a vacuum filter with heater

"Improvements in and relating to the recovery of sugar"

Abstract—This invention relates to the extraction of sugar from solutions containing impurities which inhibit crystallization of the sugar. The nature of the invention can be ascertained from claim 1 which reads as follows:—

1 In the extraction of sugar from sugar-containing liquor or juices, the step which consists in treating the liquid, after dilution if necessary, by electrolysis, thereby eliminating some of its ionised constituents, producing an insoluble precipitate, and changing its pH, thereby precipitating and bringing down suspended organic impurities.
