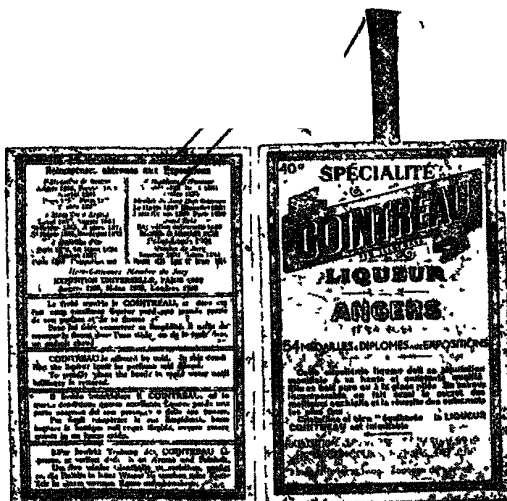

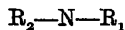

in which R<sub>1</sub> and R<sub>2</sub> each represent a hydrogen atom or a hydro-carbon group which does not comprise more than 16 carbon atoms, the nitroso group being present in ortho, meta or para position, according to Patent Application No 4,046 characterised in that the above-defined aryl nitroso compounds are employed in the form of metal salt complexes, and preferably in the form of complexes in which the metal salt component has a neutral or acid character and, in particular, complexes in which the metal salt component is derived from an inorganic acid

“ Improved coconut product and process therefor ”

*Abstract*—The invention relates to an improved coconut product and to a process for providing such a product. The nature of the invention can be ascertained from claims 1, 2, 14 and 15 which read as follows —

1 A process for treating coconut which comprises contacting the meat of the inner surface portion of the nut endosperm with a aqueous solution of sulphur dioxide whereby yellowing of the nut meat during subsequent commercial storage and distribution is substantially prevented.

2. The process defined in claim 1, including the step of washing the coconut after the SO<sub>2</sub> treatment, thereby reducing the SO<sub>2</sub> residual in the final product

14. Edible desiccated coconut meat protected against yellowing by an SO<sub>2</sub> residual content not greater than 500 ppm and characterised in that the major portion of the SO<sub>2</sub> content is concentrated in the meat of the inner surface portion of the coconut endosperm

*Abstract*—This invention relates to the manufacture of protein filaments. According to the invention the process comprises the extruding of solution of animal or vegetable protein into an acid coagulating bath and treating the bundle of filaments so formed with an aqueous solution of an alkaline salt whose reaction with the residual acid forms a gas, this gas so formed has the effect of splaying out the filaments, thus facilitating the penetration of the solution to the inside of the bundles
