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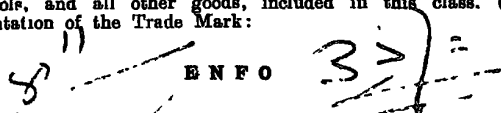

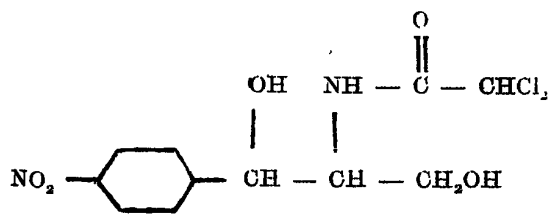

"Mono-esters of acylamido diols and methods for obtaining the same"

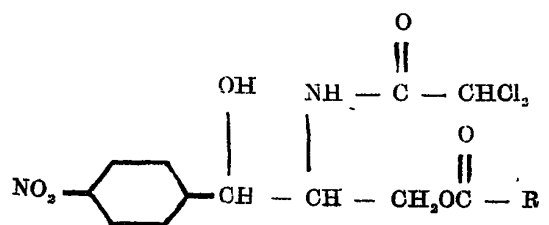
Abstract.—This invention relates to esters and methods for obtaining the same. The nature of the invention can be ascertained from Claim 1 which reads as follows.—

1. Process which comprises reacting a 1-p-nitrophenyl-2-dichloroacetamidopropane-1, 3-diol of formula,

with a sufficient quantity of an acyl halide or acyl anhydride to produce a 1-p-nitrophenyl-2-dichloroacetamido-3-acyloxypropane-1-ol compound of formula,

"Improvements in or relating to roofing tiles"

Abstract—This invention relates to roofing tiles. It has for its object an improved tile which in use for the construction of a roof would provide a double interlock which would remain water-tight even under the most adverse conditions. It consists of a tile which is provided along the longitudinal edges of its upper and lower surfaces with projections and grooves which are adapted to form a double interlock with one another, characterised in that the longitudinal edge of the upper surface would overlap the said double interlock completely and thereby ensure that the longitudinal groove of the said double interlock does not leave any longitudinal groove exposed upwards

"Improvements in or relating to the manufacture of cables"

Abstract—The nature of the invention can be ascertained from Claims 1, 2, 3 and 4 which read as follows.—

1. A plant for manufacturing cables in which a number of spool carriers, each having rotatably mounted thereon at least two spools for wires or strands to form said cable, said spool carriers being easily attachable and detachable in relation to cable stranding machines contained in said plant

2. A plant according to claim 1, in which each spool carrier comprises two side walls in right angle to the axes of rotation of said spools rotatably mounted therein, and means for rigidly connecting said side walls.

3. A plant according to claim 1 or 2, in which bearings are provided in the side walls of the spool carrier for rotatably mounting spool shafts to which the spools are fixed.

4. A plant according to claim 3, in which one end of each spool shaft is adapted to engage driving means for rotating the spools during the operation for winding wires or strands on to the spools

"Process for preparation of a Propane Derivative"

Abstract.—This invention relates to improvements in the production of a propane derivative. The nature of the invention can be ascertained from claims 1 and 2 which read as follows —

1. Process for the preparation of 2-dichloroacetamido-1-para-nitrophenyl-propane 1, 3-diol which comprises treating a dichloromethyl oxazoline of 2-amino-1-para-nitrophenyl-propane 1, 3-diol with dilute acid followed by neutralisation of the reaction mixture with a base at a temperature not greater than 30°C.

2. Process according to claim 1 wherein the oxazoline starting material is a 2-dichloromethyl-4-para-nitrophenyl-hydroxymethyl-Δ²-oxazoline
