1. The Minutes of Proceedings of the Meeting held on November 2 were read and confirmed.
2. The following documents were laid on the table:—Statements of Receipts and Disbursements on account of the Municipal Fund from end of 1894 to October 31 last; separate statements in respect of the General Revenue, Police Assessment, and Water Rate accounts; Progress Report of Work done brought up to the same date; Return of Work done by the Municipal Magistrate, and of Cases instituted by the several Inspectors during the month of October; and Health Officer's Report.

Resolved,—That the several statements, as required by section 90 of the Ordinance No. 7 of 1887, be forwarded, with the Minutes of Proceedings of this Meeting, to the Colonial Secretary for publication in the *Government Gazette*.

3.
