### GENERAL CONDITIONS APPLICABLE TO APPOINTMENTS TO POSTS IN THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT SERVICE ADVERTISED IN PART IV OF THE “CEYLON GOVERNMENT GAZETTE”

1. *Allowances.*—Unless otherwise stated, Rent Allowance, temporary Cost of Living Allowance and temporary Special Living Allowance are payable according to Government Rates and Conditions.

2. *Conditions of Service.*—Appointments will be subject to the provisions of the Local Government Service Ordinance, No. 43 of 1945, as amended by the Local Government Service (Transitional Provisions) Ordinance, No. 5 of 1946, any further amendments of Ordinance No. 43 of 1945, and the Regulations made thereunder, and other conditions of service as laid down by the Commission from time to time.

3. *Terms of Engagement.*—The posts specified in the schedule published in Part IV of the *Ceylon Government Gazette* No. 10,432 of August 8, 1952, and other posts added thereto from time to time while held by members of the Local Government Service other than females are pensionable under the Local Government Service Pension Scheme Regulations, 1952.

(a) The pension rights of officers serving under Government will be conserved if released under Section 21 of the Government Minutes on Pensions, and transferred to pensionable posts in the Local Government Service.

(b) In the case of employees of Local Authorities who hold pensionable posts under the Pension

By-laws or Rules of the Local Authorities, the payment of their pension on ultimate retirement will be governed by the Pension By-laws or Rules of the Local Authority in whose employ they were on the date immediately preceding the date of their transfer to the Local Government Service, in terms of Section 48 of the Local Government Service Ordinance, No. 43 of 1945, as amended by the Local Government Service (Amendment) Act, No. 8 of 1949.

(c) All appointees to pensionable posts other than females, officers above the age of 55 and officers who were holding pensionable posts in Government Service on the date immediately prior to their appointment to the Local Government Service, are required to contribute 4 per cent. of their salary to the Local Government Service Widows' and Orphans' Pension Fund established under the Local Government Service Widows' and Orphans' Pension Fund Regulations, 1952, published in the *Government Gazette Extraordinary* No. 10,429 of July 30, 1952. The Local Authority will contribute 3 per cent. of salary.

(d) Appointees may be required to furnish security either in cash or by Fidelity Guarantee Bond through a Guarantee Association approved by the Local Government Service Commission in a sum which may be decided upon by the Local Authority.

(e) Appointees not holding scheduled posts in the Local Government Service or permanent posts in the Public Service will be required to pass a medical examination by a duly qualified medical practitioner as to their physical fitness to serve in any part of the Island.

(f) The appointment will generally be on probation or subject to confirmation after a period of one year unless otherwise specified.

4. *Qualifications required.*—Every applicant must furnish satisfactory proof that he is a Ceylonese. The term "Ceylonese" for all purposes of recruitment to the Local Government Service is defined as a citizen of Ceylon by descent or by registration.

5. *War Service Concession.*—Provided they are qualified in all other respects, ex-Servicemen of Her Majesty's Fighting Forces and full-time members of the Auxiliary Fire, Air Raid Precautions and Civil Defence Services (excluding those who had left these Services of their own accord) will be allowed to deduct periods of such service (commencing from September 3, 1939, at the earliest and up to December 31, 1949, at the latest) from their ages for purposes of eligibility alone, provided that they joined the Forces before August 15, 1945, and that such service was satisfactory and continuous.

6. *Age Concession.*—Members of the Local Government Service are eligible to apply irrespective of age for posts advertised in the Local Government Service.

7. *Other Requirements.*—(i) Applications from those in a Local Body should be forwarded through the Municipal Commissioner or Chairman of the Local Authority in which they are serving.

(ii) Applications from officers in the Government Service should be forwarded through the Heads of their respective Departments. In the case of applications from officers holding permanent posts in the Government Service, the Head of the Department concerned should, when forwarding the application, state whether or not he is prepared to release the applicant if selected.

(iii) Candidates may be required to present themselves for interview or test at an appointed time and place. No travelling or other expenses will be paid in this connection.

(iv) Any person who desires to recommend a candidate may do so by giving a testimonial. Any form of direct or indirect canvassing or attempt to influence the selection of candidates will disqualify such candidates.

(v) Any statement in the application which is found to be incorrect will render the applicant liable to disqualification if the inaccuracy is discovered before the selection and to dismissal after the selection.

(vi) Applications not conforming in every respect with the requirements of this advertisement will be rejected.

### THE HOUSING AND TOWN IMPROVEMENT ORDINANCE

THE following resolution passed by the Senate, at a meeting held on April 11, 1955, and by the House of Representatives at a meeting held on April 26, 1955, is published for general information:—

"This House resolves under the provisions of section 3, (b) of the Housing and Town Improvement Ordinance (Chapter 199), as modified by the Proclamation published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 9,773 of September 24, 1947, that from the

first day of July, 1955, the aforesaid Ordinance shall be in force within each of the areas defined in the Schedule hereto :—

#### Schedule

1. All that area of land situated within the built up locality of Mawanella and bounded as follows :—

*North.*—By a line drawn from a point on the right bank of Mahaoya where the centre line of the Gansabhawa path meets the said bank near the north-western corner of lot 5 in Mawanella Town Survey P. Plan No. 27 eastwards along the right bank of Mahaoya till it meets the left bank of Hinguloya; thence south-eastwards along the left bank of Hinguloya till it meets the left bank of Getadeniyawe Ela.

*East.*—By a line drawn from the last-mentioned point southwards along the left bank of Getadeniyawe Ela till it meets the northern boundary of Hinguloya Mosque road; thence across the said Ela to its right bank and southwards along the land-marked boundary, Ela and ditch which form the eastern boundaries of lots 25 and 21 in Mawanella Town Survey P. Plan No. 27 and eastwards along the northern boundary of the road to Hinguloya to the land mark on the northern boundary of the said road; thence southwards across the said road and along the eastern boundary of the road and the landmarked boundary which forms part of the eastern boundary of lot 21 in Mawanella Town Survey P. Plan No. 27 and across the Colombo-Kandy road to the 56½ mile stone on the said road; thence south-westwards along the landmarked boundaries which form the eastern and southern boundaries of lots 77 and 78 in Mawanella Town Survey P. Plan No. 27 and across the Mawanella-Alpitiya road to the centre of culvert No. 1/6 on the said road.

*South.*—By a line drawn from the last-mentioned point westwards along the land-marked boundaries which form the southern boundaries of lots 120, 128, 146, 145, 144, 142, 141, 140 and eastern boundary of the ditch and southern boundary of lot 139 in Mawanella Town Survey P. Plan No. 27 (crossing Mahaoya and Mawanella-Aranayaka road near the culvert No. 8) to the land mark on the north-western corner of the land called Vidanahenayalewatta near the south-western corner of lot 139 in Mawanella Town Survey P. Plan No. 27.

*West.*—By a line drawn from the last-mentioned point northwards along the right bank of the Walaporuwela Ela and the bank and live-fence and landmarked boundary which form the western boundaries of lots 135 134 and 111 in Mawanella Town Survey P. Plan No. 27 to the eastern boundary of the Gansabhawa path from Habbunkaduwa; thence northwards crossing the Gansabhawa path and along its western boundary and the landmarked boundary which form the western boundaries of lots 105, 104, 103 and 101 to the landmark at the 55½ mile stone on the Colombo-Kandy road; thence north-eastwards across the said road and along the left bank of the Ela and the landmarked boundary which form the

western boundaries of lots 53, 52, 45, 44, 43 and 42 and the western and northern boundaries of lot 40 and the left bank of Mahaoya to the Badull tree north of the north-eastern corner of lot 40 in Mawanella Town Survey P. Plan No. 27.; thence due north-eastwards across the Mahaoya and along the right bank of the said Mahaoya to the starting point of the northern limit of the area.

2. All that area of land situated within the built up locality of Hingula and bounded as follows :—

*North.*—By a line drawn from a point on the left bank of Hinguloya due north of the centre of culvert No. 58/4 on the Colombo-Kandy road eastwards along the left bank of the Hinguloya till it meets a point due north of the centre of culvert No. 59/6 on the said Colombo-Kandy road

*East.*—By a line drawn from the last-mentioned point due southwards along a straight line crossing the centre of culvert No. 59/6 on the Colombo-Kandy road to a point 5 chains due south of the southern boundary of the said Colombo-Kandy road.

*South.*—By a line drawn from the last-mentioned point westwards along a line parallel to and at a distance of 5 chains from the southern boundary of the Colombo-Kandy road till it meets a point due south of the centre of culvert No. 58/4 on the said Colombo-Kandy road.

*West.*—By a line drawn from the last-mentioned point due northwards along a straight line crossing the centre of culvert No. 58/4 on the Colombo-Kandy road to the starting point of the northern limit of the area”.

**BY-LAWS**

1. Within the administrative limits of the Council, no person shall display or exhibit in any place any advertisement capable of being seen from any thoroughfare situated within those limits, unless—

- (1) such place has been approved by the Council, by a resolution for the time being in force, as a place suitable for that purpose, and
- (2) he has obtained a licence in that behalf from the Chairman on payment of a fee calculated at the rates specified in the Schedule hereto :

Provided, however, that this by-law shall not apply to the display or exhibition of any advertisement—

- (a) on any place of business for the purposes of that business ; or
- (b) on any premises for the purpose of advertising the fact that such premises or any articles kept or situated on such premises are to let or for sale.

2. Every contravention of by-law 1 shall be punishable with a fine not exceeding fifty rupees and in the case of a continuing contravention, with an additional fine not exceeding twenty-five rupees for every day during which the contravention is continued after conviction or after service of a written notice from the Chairman directing attention to such contravention.

3. In these by-laws—

“advertisement” means any word, letter, model, sign, placard, board, device or representation in the nature of and employed wholly or in part for the purposes of advertisement ;

“Chairman” means the Chairman of the Council ; and

“Council” means the Chilaw Urban Council.

1. An area within a circle having a radius of one quarter of a mile from each village market is hereby declared to be the market area of that market.

2. Every person using or occupying any stall, seat, or space in any village market established by the Committee shall pay for such use or occupation a fee according to the rates set out in the schedule hereto.
