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STATEMENT OF LEGAL EFFECT

Clause 2 : This clause amends the Code of Criminal Procedure (Special Provisions) Act, No. 2 of 2013 by inserting section 6A in that Act and the legal effect of the amendment is to make provisions to ensure the rights of an Attorney-at-Law who represents a person held in the police custody.

BE it enacted by the Parliament of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka as follows:-

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(6) Such Attorney-at-Law shall, if he so requests, be allowed to have access to the person in custody, unless such access is prejudicial to the investigation being conducted.

(7) Where such Attorney-at-Law makes, representations or, an application under

subsection (5), such officer shall-(a) make a record of the representations 10 so made; (b) give due consideration to such representations; and (c) record reasons for the grant or refusal of such application seeking bail. 15 (8) Every officer in charge of a police station shall, if he is not in a position to entertain representations made by an Attorney-at-Law, under this section, appoint a suitable police officer to entertain such representations. 20 (9) For the purposes of this section the expression "officer in charge of a police station" includes any other police officer representing such officer in charge of the police station.". 3.
