MUNICIPAL COUNCIL NOTICES.

MUNICIPALITY OF COLOMBO.

Minutes of Proceedings of a General Meeting of the Municipal Council of Colombo held at the Town Hall on Friday, March 13, 1896, at 3 p.m.

The Council met this day at 3 P.M., pursuant to notice dated March 7, 1896.

Present :—Mr. F. H. Price, Acting Mayor and Chairman ; Captain F. Bayley ; Mr. A. Forsyth ; Hon. A. de A. Seneviratna ; Mr. C. Perera ; Hon. P. Coomaraswamy ; Mr. C. P. Dias ; Mr. C. M. Fernando ; and Mr. A. Alvis.

The Minutes of February 14, 1896, having been printed and a copy thereof having been sent to each Member of the Council, were taken as read.

Resolved,—That the Minutes of February 14, 1896, be confirmed.

1. Pursuant to notice, Mr. C. M. Fernando moved “the re-appointment of the Special Committee appointed on September 13, 1895, to consider and report upon the gradual improvement of the sanitary condition of the over-crowded localities of the town.”

Mr. C. Perera seconded.—Carried.

2. A Supplemental Budget No. 1 for 1896, approved by the Standing Committee on February 29, 1896, was laid before the Council.

Mr. C. Perera moved "that the Supplemental Budget be sanctioned with the following additions under the Assessment Account, namely, a re-vote of Rs. 85 for repair of gas fittings in the Town Hall and a vote of Rs. 80 for a punkah and a punkah cooly."

Mr. Dias seconded.—Carried.

3. The following recommendations from the Standing Committee of February 12 and 21, 1896, were laid before the Council :—

February 12, 1896.

8.—Question of lease of quarters, Superintendent, Bridge-of-Boats.

Resolved that the lease be recommended to the Council, and that in the meantime the necessary application for sanction be made to the Government.

9.—A further remark on revenue accounts for April, 1895, *re* J. H. Nichols' case.

Resolved that the Council be recommended to order the recovery of instalments of Rs. 5 monthly from April, 1895.

17.—Auditor-General's further remark on question of Mr. Ebert's pension.

Resolved that the Council be recommended to pay Mr. Ebert a salary of Rs. 161.11 per mensem, and that during the payment of such salary Mr. Ebert's pension be suspended.

February 21, 1896.

6.—Letter from Colonial Secretary about measures for protecting city from fire.

Resolved that the Council be recommended to address the Inspector-General of Police with a request for a revised scheme for an efficient fire brigade. [Mr. C. Perera and Mr. C. P. Dias dissent.]

Mr. Alwis moved "the adoption of the foregoing recommendations of the Standing Committee."

Hon. P. Coomaraswamy seconded.—Carried.

4. A report dated February 19, 1896, of the Special Committee on the question of disposal of night soil from private latrines, was laid before the Council, having been previously printed and circulated.

Hon. P. Coomaraswamy moved "that the consideration of the above report be deferred."

Mr. Dias seconded.—Carried.

5. A report dated February 19, 1896, of the Special Committee on the question of sanitation and drainage, was laid before the Council, having been previously printed and circulated.

Mr. C. Perera moved the adoption of the Special Committee's report.

Mr. C. M. Fernando seconded.—Carried.

6. A report dated February 19, 1896, of the Special Committee on the question of incineration, was laid before the Council, having been previously printed and circulated.

Mr. C. P. Dias moved the adoption of the Special Committee's report.

Mr. Alwis seconded.—Carried.

7. A report dated February 17, 1896, of the Special Committee on tramways, was laid before the Council, having been previously printed and circulated.

Mr. Alwis moved the adoption of the Special Committee's report.

Hon. P. Coomaraswamy seconded, Carried. Mr. Dias dissenting.

8. A report dated February 19, 1896, of the Special Committee on extra-mural cemeteries, was laid before the Council, having been previously printed and circulated.

Mr. Dias moved the adoption of the Special Committee's report.

Hon. P. Coomaraswamy seconded.—Carried.

9. A Statement of Receipts and Disbursements from January 1 to February 29, 1896, and a Progress Report of work done during February, 1896, were laid on the table.

10. A letter was read dated February 14, 1896, and addressed to the Chairman by Mr. M. Finlay resigning office.

11. A letter was read dated February 24, 1896, and addressed to the Chairman and Members of the Municipal Council by the Hon. Sir John J. Grinlinton resigning office.

12. A notification dated March 6, 1896, from the Chairman was read, to the effect that Mr. R. H. Morgan having been absent from three consecutive General Meetings had vacated his seat as a Member of Council.

Mr. C. Perera moved "that Mr. R. H. Morgan be restored to office, in accordance with the provisions of clause 32 of Ordinance No. 7 of 1887."

Mr. Alwis seconded.—Carried.

13. An application for leave dated February 27, 1896, from Mr. A. Weinman, Clerk, Assessment Department, was laid before the Council.

Resolved,—That the leave applied for from February 13 to 26, 1896, be sanctioned.

14. The Auditor-General's remarks on the accounts for August, September, and October, 1895, received with letters Nos. 16, 22, and 27 of February 10 and 24 and March 6, 1896, were laid on the table.

15. The City Analyst's report dated February 27, 1896, on the town water for February 1896, was laid on the table, having been previously printed and circulated.

16. Reports of Inspectors on licensed carriages, and kerosine, poison, and gunpowder shops, for March, 1896, were laid on the table.
