MUNICIPAL COUNCIL NOTICES.

COLOMBO MUNICIPALITY.

Minutes of Proceedings of a General Meeting of the Municipal Council of Colombo held in the Town Hall on Friday, April 17, 1896, at 3 p.m.

THE Council met this day at 3 p.m., pursuant to notice dated April 10, 1896.

Present:—Mr. F. H. Price, Mayor and Acting Chairman; Hon. R. K. Mac Bride, C.M.G.; Major L. F. Knollys; C.M.G.,; Brigade-Surgeon Lieut.-Col. A. W. Duke; Hon. A. de A. Seneviratne; Mr. M. I. M. Haniffa; Mr. C. Perera; Mr. Walter Pereira; and Mr. A. Alvis.

The Minutes of March 13, 1896, having been printed, and a copy thereof having been sent to each Member of the Council, were taken as read.

Resolved,—That the Minutes of March 13, 1896, be confirmed.

- 1. In the absence of Hon. P. Coomaraswamy, it was resolved that the following motion standing in his name be deferred till next Meeting:—
- "To move that this Council do make a recommendation to his Excellency the Governor, in terms of section 2 of Ordinance No. 2 of 1894, for the establishment of a new cremation ground in the Cinnamon Gardens."
 - 2. The following recommendation of the Standing Committee of March 20, 1896, was laid before the Council:—(9) Question of leasing mutton market, Slave Island.
 - Resolved that the lease for the period between May 1, 1896, and December 31, 1896, be offered for sale at public auction.
- Mr. C. Perera moved "that the lease either of the whole market, or of each stall separately, be offered for sale accordingly.

 Mr. Alvis seconded.—Carried.
- 3. The Chairman's Administration Report for 1895 was laid before the Council, having been previously printed and circulated.

Mr. C. Perera moved "that the report be referred to a Special Committee consisting of Captain F. Bayley, Dr. W. R. Kynsey, Hon. A. de A. Seneviratne, Mr. C. Perera, Mr. C. P. Dias, Mr. C. M. Fernando, and Mr. A. Alvis—three Members to form a quorum."

Mr. Walter Pereira seconded.—Carried.

4. A further report dated April 15, 1896, of the Special Committee on tramways, was laid before the Council, having been previously printed and circulated.

Mr. C. Perera moved "that the report of the Special Committee be adopted."

Mr. Haniffa seconded.—Carried.

- 5. A Statement of Receipts and Disbursements from January 1 to March 31, 1896, and a Progress Report of Work done during March, 1896, were laid on the table.
- 6. The Auditor-General's remarks on the accounts for November and December, 1895, received with letters Nos. 29 and 32 of March 21 and 31, 1896, were laid on the table.
- 7. The City Analyst's report dated March 30 on the town water for March, 1896, was laid on the table, having been previously printed and circulated.

8. An application dated March 25, 1896, from Mr. Carnie, Clerk, Sanitary Department, for two months' leave

of absence, was laid before the Council.

The Chairman explained that he had granted Mr. Carnie 30 days' leave under the provisions of section 61 of Ordinance 7 of 1887, and that it remained for the Council to determine whether the additional leave applied for should be allowed.

Resolved,—That the leave applied for be granted.

- Reports of Inspectors on licensed carriages, and on kerosine, poison, and gunpowder shops for April, 1896, were laid on the table.
- 10. A letter dated March 18, 1896, from the Chairman, Mr. Pennycuick, with reference to an extension of his leave of absence until June 2, 1896, was laid before the Council.

Resolved,—That the extension of leave applied for be recommended to Government.

11. A letter No. 32 dated April 13, 1896, from the Colonial Secretary, with reference to sharing the expense of a report on the drainage of Colombo, was laid before the Council.

Mr. C. Perera moved that the receipt of the letter be acknowledged with thanks, and that the conditions

specified therein be accepted; further, that the Government be asked to select an engineer.

Hon. A. de A. Seneviratne seconded.—Carried.
