THE RUBBER REPLANTING SUBSIDY ACT, No. 36 OF 1953

IT is hereby notified that the following resolution under section 7 (5) of the Rubber Replanting Subsidy Act, No. 36 of 1953, has been passed by the House of Representatives at its public session on January 12, 1956.

Resolution

This House resolves under sub-section (5) of section 7 of the Rubber Replanting Subsidy Act, No. 36 of 1953, as amended by Act No. 1 of 1955, that, with effect from January 12, 1956,—

- (1) the export duty levied under sub-section (1) of that section shall be fifteen cents for every pound of sheet rubber exported from Ceylon,
- (2) the export duty levied under sub-section (3) of that section shall, except as otherwise provided in the succeeding paragraph (3), be fifteen cents for every

pound of crepe rubber (other than scrap crepe rubber) exported from Ceylon, and

- (3) the export duty levied under sub-section (3) of that section shall be ten cents for every pound of crepe rubber (other than scrap crepe rubber) exported from Ceylon within two months of the aforesaid date and in respect of which the Principal Collector of Customs is satisfied—

(a) that the exportation is in execution of a valid contract entered into by the exporter with a person outside Ceylon before the aforesaid date, and

(b) that—

- (i) before the aforesaid date such rubber was his property and was stored within the Municipality of Colombo or Galle either by him or, if such rubber was purchased by him from any other person, by that other person, or
- (ii) such rubber was purchased by him from a manufacturer thereof in execution of a valid contract entered into before the aforesaid date
