THE GOVERNMENT-SPONSORED CORPORATIONS ACT, No. 19 OF 1955

Order under Section 2

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by sub-section (1) of section 2 of the Government-Sponsored Corporations Act, No. 19 of 1955, I, Kanthiah Vaithianathan Minister of Industries, Housing and Social Services do by this Order, with the approval of the Government—

- (1) specify the Plywood Factory and Saw Mill maintained by the Government at Gmtota in the Southern Province, as the manufactory to which this Order relates.
- (2) declare that a corporation shall be established to take over and carry out the purposes of the aforesaid manufactory,
- (3) assign the corporate name "Gmtota Plywoods" to the corporation;
- (4) specify the objects set out in the first Schedule hereto as the objects of the corporation.
- (5) determine—
 - (a) that the initial capital of the corporation shall be Rs. 2,800,000,
 - (b) that the said capital shall be divided into 280,000 ordinary shares
 - (c) that the amount of each share shall be rupees ten, and
 - (d) that the rights specified in the Second Schedule hereto shall be the rights attached to the shares,
- (6) that the principal place of business shall be Colombo,
- (7) fix five as the number of members of the Board of Directors of the corporation when the Government holds the entire capital of the corporation;
- (8) appoint the following persons as the first members of the Board of Directors of the corporation—

FIRST SCHEDULE

THE OBJECTS OF THE CORPORATION

- The objects of the corporation shall be—
- (1) To manufacture and sell plywood and articles made of plywood
 - (2) To saw and sell all kinds of timber
 - (3) To manufacture and sell battens, door and window panels and items of furniture

- assign the corporate name Paranthan Chemicals to the corporation;
- specify the objects set out in the First Schedule hereto as the objects of the corporation,
- determine—
 - that the initial capital of the corporation shall be Rs 15,682,000,
 - that the said capital shall be divided into Rs 1,568,200 ordinary shares,
 - that the amount of each share shall be rupees ten, and
 - that the rights specified in the Second Schedule hereto shall be the rights attached to the shares;
- state that the principal place of business of the corporation shall be Colombo;

FIRST SCHEDULE

OBJECTS OF THE CORPORATION

The objects of the corporation shall be—

- to manufacture and sell Dichloro-diphenyl-trichloroethane (D D T)—caustic soda, chlorine, sulphuric acid, fatty alcohols, fertilizers, insecticides, fungicides, pesticides, agricultural chemicals and detergents of every description;
- to supply electrical energy to any person,
- to manufacture and sell any by-products which may be produced in the process of manufacturing any of the articles specified above
