MUNICIPAL COUNCIL NOTICES.

MUNICIPALITY OF COLOMBO.

Minutes of Proceedings of a General Meeting of the Municipal Council of Colombo held at the Town Hall on Friday, May 8, 1896, at 3 p.m.

The Council met this day at 3 P.M., pursuant to notice dated May 2, 1896.

Present:—Mr. F. H. Price, Mayor and Acting Chairman; Captain F. Bayley; Hon. R. K. MacBride, C.M.G.; Dr. W. R. Kynsey, C.M.G.; Major L. F. Knollys, C.M.G.; Mr. A. Forsyth; Brigade Surgeon Lieut.-Col. A. W. Duke, A.M.S.; Mr. M. I. M. Haniffa; Mr. C. Perera; Hon. P. Coomaraswamy; Mr. C. P. Dias; Mr. Walter Pereira; Mr. R. H. Morgan; Mr. C. M. Fernando; and Mr. A. Alvis.

The Minutes of April 17, 1896, having been printed, and a copy thereof having been sent to each Member of the Council, were taken as read.

Resolved,—That the Minutes of April 17, 1896, be confirmed.

1. Pursuant to notice Hon. P. Coomaraswamy moved "that this Council do make a recommendation to His Excellency the Governor, in terms of section 2 of Ordinance 2 of 1894, for the establishment of a new cremation ground in the Cinnamon Gardens."

This motion was, by leave of Council, amended by the addition of the following words: "after the site referred to in letter No. 316 of February 12, 1896, from the Government Agent to P. Ramanathan, Esq., has been approved by the Municipal Council."

The motion so amended was seconded by Mr. M. I. M. Haniffa and carried.

2. Pursuant to notice Hon. P. Coomaraswamy moved "that it be ascertained from the Government Agent, Western Province, with reference to the recent gunpowder explosion at Kayman's Gate, what quantity of gunpowder was stored in the premises."

This motion was, by leave of Council, withdrawn.

3. Pursuant to notice Hon. P. Coomaraswamy moved "that the attention of the Government be called to the proceedings held at the inquest on May 1 on the body of Wapoo Saibo, and to the opinion of the jurors that the storage of gunpowder should not be permitted in crowded localities."

Seconded by Mr. Alvis.—Carried.

4. Pursuant to notice Mr. R. H. Morgan moved "that the Kollupitiya market and the Kollupitiya latrine be now removed, a suitable site for another market having now been selected in pursuance of the resolution of Council at its Meeting of November 8, 1895, and a suitable site for a new latrine in the same neighbourhood as the existing latrine having been also selected."

Seconded by Hon. R. K. MacBride.

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Dr. Kynsey moved as an amendment "that the Kollupitiya latrine be removed at once, and the Kollupitiya market be left where it is.' The Council divided on the amendment:-

- 5. The following recommendations from the Standing Committee of April 27, 1896, were laid before the Council :-
 - By-laws on bakeries,—Resolved that the by-laws as now amended be recommended to the Council. (30A) Additional clerk for Department of Works, — Resolved upon the employment of an additional clerk on Rs. 25 per mensem, to attend solely to the preparation of returns in connection with works executed under the supervision of the head overseers.
 - (32) Scavenging Contract, Resolved that the contractor be called upon to show cause why the contract should not be determined in terms of the 7th clause of the contract.

Resolved, with reference to the by-laws on bakeries, that in by-law 6, "30" be substituted for "10."

Resolved,—That the by-laws be adopted with the foregoing amendment.

Mr. Dias moved the adoption of the recommendations of the Standing Committee, 30A and 32. Seconded by Dr. Kynsey.-Carried.

6 A letter No. 38 of April 29, 1896, from the Colonial Secretary, intimating the intention of the Government to ascertain from the Crown Agents the cost of duplicating the water-main from Wagga, was laid before the Council.

Mr. C. Perera moved "that the letter be acknowledged with thanks, and that Government be asked to be so good as to ascertain what additional quantity of water will be available to the public by such duplication, and what

will be the cost of the duplication of the whole length from the Labugama Reservoir. Also to inquire what are the engineering reasons for stopping short at Wagga.

Seconded by Dr. Kynsey.-Carried.

- 7. The further report of the Special Committee on tramways was not ready.
- The annual report of audit for 1895, received with letter No. 43 of April 21, 1896, from the Auditor-General, was laid before the Council.

Mr. C. Perera moved "that the report be referred to the Special Committee on the Chairman's Administration Report for 1895.

Mr. Dias seconded.—Carried.

- 9. A Statement of Receipts and Disbursements from January 1 to April 30, 1896, and a Progress Report of Work done during April, 1896, were laid on the table.
- 10. The Auditor General's remarks on the accounts for January, 1896, received with letter No. 47 of April 27, 1896, were laid on the table.
- 11. The City Analyst's report dated May 4, 1896, on the town water for April, 1896, was laid on the table. having been previously printed and circulated.
- 12. Reports of Inspectors on licensed carriages, and on shops used for the sale of kerosine, poisons, and gunpowder for May, 1896, were laid on the table.
- 13. The Sanitary Officer's report for the first quarter of 1896 was laid on the table, having been previously printed and circulated.
- An application dated May 4, 1896, from the Shroff, Mr. M. C. Corea, for an extension of leave, was laid before the Council. This application was withdrawn by a subsequent letter dated May 7, 1896.
- Mr. Morgan moved that the Shroff be required to furnish fresh and approved security before he is allowed to return to duty.
