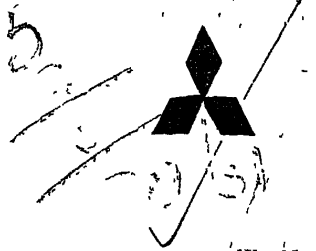

"Improvements in or relating to high grade rubber and method of making same"

Abstract—This invention relates to the production of high grade rubber from rubber latex According to the invention the skim latex resulting from the centrifugal concentration of a natural rubber latex is allowed to coagulate spontaneously (as in an open vat or tank) The resulting coagulum is reduced to a wet crumb or lacy crepe by milling The wet crumb or crepe thus obtained is treated with an aqueous alkali metal hydroxide solution, washed and then dried.

"Improvements relating to containers for liquids"

Abstract—This invention relates to containers for liquids According to the present invention, a pouring spout for use with or for incorporation with a liquid container includes the provision of a pouring lip at the end of the pouring spout and a gutter formed in the spout and connecting the pouring lip with the neck of the spout or the body of the container or vessel

"Improvements in or relating to writing instruments"

Abstract—This invention relates to fountain pens of the ball tip type An object of the invention is to provide protection for the ink from contact with air and also to prevent same from escaping through the air inlet into the ink reservoir According to the invention there is transposed between the column of ink in the reservoir and the air inlet a liquid or a viscous or paste like mass which does not mix with the ink and forms an air-tight plug which moves with the surface of the ink column.

" A method of dehydrating coconut milk compound "

Abstract —According to the invention the kernel of the coconut is scraped, passed through a fine cutter and desiccated until the coconut turns oily. Now this desiccated coconut is pressed until its maximum oil content gets extracted. This desiccated and pressed coconut is hereinafter called " dehydrated coconut compound ". This dehydrated coconut compound is

mixed with the milk expressed from an equal quantity of coconut kernel. The mixture is dried in a desiccator until it turns oily. It is then pressed to remove the oil as completely as possible. This process may be repeated to obtain a greater concentration if so required. This " dehydrated coconut milk compound " is then dried in a suitable drier until sufficiently dry to be powdered.
