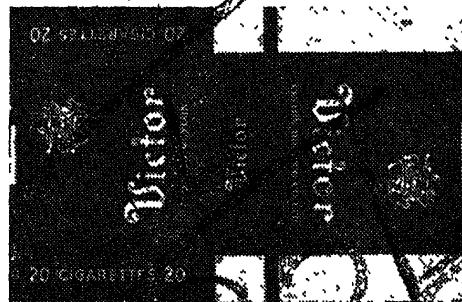

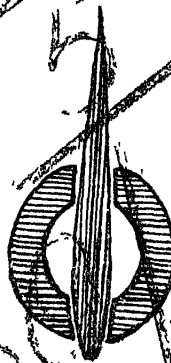

"Process for the catalytic reforming of light gasoline fractions."

Abstract—The invention relates to a process for the catalytic reforming of hydrocarbon mixtures containing low boiling paraffin hydrocarbons. The nature of the invention can be ascertained from claim 1 which is as follows:—

1 Process for improving the octane number of the lighter fraction, boiling up to about 95°C to 110°C, of paraffinic gasolines, by catalytic reforming, characterized in that the starting mixture is separated into a fraction boiling below approximately 65°C and one boiling above approximately 65°C, the fraction boiling above approximately 65°C being catalytically reformed and the reformed product thus obtained being blended with the fraction boiling below approximately 65°C

"An improved method of withering or drying tea or other like materials"

Abstract—According to the invention, the method comprises subjecting the material to the action of a drying medium in two or more stages, a subsequent stage being effected in one or more chambers having a capacity equal approximately to the bulk of the material at the termination of the preceding stage

“Improvements in pneumatic tyres.”

Abstract — The invention relates to pneumatic tyres and to a method and apparatus for their production. The nature of the invention can be ascertained from claim 1 which is as follows —

1. A pneumatic tyre comprising a body of natural rubber or other suitable resilient material containing, as an internal reinforcement, a winding of cord arranged in the form of at least one double layer in which the cord of one layer crosses the cord of the other layer to form a lattice and the cord in each

layer extends in a series of unit waves progressing continuously around the tyre in the same direction, each wave consisting of two substantially diagonally opposite arcuate portions, each extending round one edge of the tyre, alternating with portions passing through the side walls and crown of the tyre which leave and approach the edges substantially tangentially and take a path which is substantially a geodesic with respect to the surface defined by the layer, the arcuate portions of cord in the unit waves being sufficiently long to ensure that, on inflation of the tyre, the edges thereof will tend to contract as a result of the tension imposed on the cord
