By virtue of the powers vested in me by section 26 of the Courts Ordinance (Chapter 6), as modified by the Proclamation under section 88(1) of the Ceylon (Constitution) Order in Council, 1946, published in *Gazette Extraordinary* No 9,773 of September 24, 1947, I, Hema Henry Basnayake, Chief Justice, after previous consultation with the Judges of the Supreme Court, do hereby for sufficient reasons to me appearing order that a Criminal Sessions of the Supreme Court for the Southern Circuit be holden at Matara on the 25th day of April 1956 in addition to the Criminal Sessions of the Supreme Court to be holden at Galle on the said 25th day of April 1956

WHEREAS it is provided by section 26 of the Courts Ordinance (Chapter 6), that a Criminal Sessions of the Supreme Court for the Eastern Circuit shall be holden by one of the Judges thereof or by a Commissioner of Assize at Batticaloa and such other place or places in such circuit as the Chief Justice, after previous consultation with the Judges shall appoint such Sessions commencing at Batticaloa in the months of February and July in every year

AND WHEREAS it is further provided that it shall be competent for the Chief Justice for sufficient reasons to him appearing to alter the dates above mentioned, after previous consultation with the Judges and to fix any other dates for the commencement of the above Sessions

AND WHEREAS an order made by me in consultation with the Judges was published in *Gazette* No 10,893 of February 17, 1956, fixing Monday, 2nd April 1956, as the date of commencement of the Sessions for the 1st Eastern Circuit, 1956

AND WHEREAS it has become necessary to alter the said date and fix a place other than Batticaloa for the commencement of the said Sessions

I, HEMA HENRY BASNAYAKE, Chief Justice for sufficient reasons to me appearing do hereby after previous consultation with the Judges revoke the order published in *Gazette* No 10,893 of February 17, 1956, and fix Monday, 23rd April 1956, as the date, and Trincomalee as the place, for the commencement of the Sessions for the 1st Eastern circuit, 1956
