## Part V—Notice to Revoke or Suspend Private Carrier's Permits under Regulation 12 of the Motor Traffic (Goods Carriage) Regulations, 1951

IN terms of section 94 (2) of the Motor Traffic Act, No 14 of 1951, and regulation 18 of the Motor Traffic (Goods Carriage) Regulations, 1951, notice is hereby given that a public inquiry will be held into the proposed revocation or suspension of the Private Carrier's Permit given below on the date, time and place shown against the permit.

2. (i) At a public enquiry no person other than the permit holder and every person who has duly made representation relating to the revocation or suspension, shall be entitled to be heard.

(ii) The Commissioner may, in his discretion, permit any person other than a person referred to in paragraph 2 (i) above to be heard at a public inquiry

(iii) The Commissioner may, in his discretion, refuse to hear at a public inquiry any person if he is satisfied that the views of that person have already been stated adequately by some other person at that inquiry
