The Rules made under the Council of Legal Education Incorporation Ordinance, 1900, as last amended by notification dated October 15, 1956, published in *Ceylon Government Gazette* No 10,988 of November 2, 1956, were further amended at a meeting of the Council held on March 1, 1957, as follows —

Schedule III § by the addition of the following at the end of the sentence in line 4 —

Such clerk shall not during the period of his articles be engaged in any other business, vocation or employment between the hours of 9 a.m. and 4.30 p.m. on week days, and between the hours of 9 a.m. and 12 noon on Saturdays and shall devote his entire time during these hours to the study of law and to the professional business of the Proctor to whom he is attached
