Selection of Candidates for Admission to the **Nurses' Training Schools**

APPLICATIONS are invited from unmarried women candidates for selection as Pupil Nurses at the Nurses' Training Schools.

- 2. Qualifications required.—Every applicant must furnish satisfactory proof that she-
 - (a) is not less than 17 and not more than 25 years of age on March 3, 1956, except in the case of Emergency Nurses and female employees in the Department, V. A. D. Nurses and those who were in the service, in whose case the maximum age limit will be 32;
 - (b) has passed the Senior School Certificate or equivalent (English) or higher examination:
 - c) has a minimum height of 4 feet 8 inches;
 - (d) is of good character and of sound constitution and is physically fit to serve in any part of the Island.

- (ii) a valid passport issued within three years of the date of the examination; or
- (iii) any certificates, licence or other documents embodying a photograph of the holder and issued within three years of the date of the examination on the authority of a Government Department.
- (e) Candidates who reach a satisfactory standard in the written examination will be called up for the viva voce on a date and time specified and to be held in Colombo. They will be informed individually regarding the viva-voce. The originals of the certificates referred to in paragraph 3 (d) above should be produced by each candidate at the viva-voce test. The viva-voce test will be conducted by a Board appointed by the Director of Health Services.
- 5. Notification of Selection.—The names of the successful candidates will be published in the important local English newspapers. The candidates who are not selected at the viva-voce or the written examination will not be individually informed regarding their non-selection.
- 6. Medical Examination.—Selected candidates will be required to undergo a medical examination as to physical fitness to serve as a nurse in any part of the Island. No candidate will be selected who does not pass the medical examination.
