The Government contribution, in either case, will be equal to $7\frac{1}{2}$ per cent. of the salary paid in at the close of each financial year.

(ii) Appointees may be required to furnish security in terms of the Public Officers (Security) Ordinance, if so required by the Head of their Department.

(iii) Appointees other than those already in the Public Service will be required to pass a medical examination by a Government Medical Officer as to their physical fitness to serve in any part of the Island

War Service Concession.—Provided they are qualified in all other respects ex-Servicemen of Her Majesty's Fighting Forces and full-time members of the Auxiliary Fire, Air Raid Precautions and Civil Defence Services (excluding those who had left these Services of their own accord), will be allowed to deduct periods of such service commencing from September 3, 1939, at the earliest, and up to December 31, 1949, at the latest from their ages for purposes of eligibility alone, provided that they joined the Forces before August 15, 1945, and that such service was satisfactory and continuous.

Other Requirements — (i) Applications from officers of the Public Service, who are qualified must be forwarded through the Heads of their respective Departments. In the case of applications from officers holding permanent posts in the Public Service, the Heads of the Departments concerned should, in forwarding the applications state whether or not they are prepared to release the applicants (if selected) in accordance with Administrative Regulation 109 of the Manual of Procedure.

APPLICATIONS are invited for (i) two posts of Superintendent of Translations (Sinhalese) and (ii) two posts of Superintendent of Translations (Tamil) in the Official Languages Department. Applications, which should be on a special form obtainable from this office, should reach me on or before the following dates :-

2. Salary.—The salary scale attached to the post is Rs. 6,240—6 of 360 and 10 of 480—Rs. 13,200 (efficiency bars before Rs. 8,400 and Rs. 11,760 and two years on Rs. 11,280) per annum.

3. Terms of Engagement.—(i) The posts are permanent and pensionable. The appointment will

be on probation for 2 years. (ii) The selected candidates will be required to take up appointments at short notice. The func-tions of the selected officers will be translating original documents including legal and techni-cal matter as well as revising, standardizing and editing translations including legal and technical matter before publication.

(iii) A specially qualified candidate may be placed at a higher point than the initial of the scale in consultation with the Treasury, if he possesses high qualifications and experience which make him eminently suitable for the post.

CEYLON GOVERNMENT RAILWAY

Recruitment of Special Apprentices for Posts in the Minor Supervising Grades-Ratmalana Workshops and Running Sheds

APPLICATIONS are invited for posts of Special Apprentices to be trained to fill vacancies in the Minor Supervising Grade in the Railway Workshops and Running Sheds.

2. Eligibility.—(i) Applicants should be un-married and must be of good physique. (ii) Applicants must have passed the Senior School Certificate (English) Examination with "Mathematics", its equivalent or higher examination with "Mathematics".

ORIGINAL certificates must be forwarded with the application. Copies will not be accepted. Certificates must clearly state that the applicant has passed the required examination. It will not suffice for an applicant to forward a certificate stating that he "was studying in" or "left from" a higher class. Applicants forwarding such certificates will be disqualified.

3. (i) A certificate of registration of the applicant's birth showing him to be not less than 16 or more than 21 years of age on December 10, 1955,

must be attached to the application. Certificates of birth issued for purposes of admission to schools, affidavits or baptismal certificates will not be accepted as substitutes for birth certificates.

(ii) Ex-Servicemen who claim the concession of age in terms of the general conditions given at the beginning of this *Gazette* must forward the original of their discharge certificates in proof of their satisfactory service. The certificate should, in addition, include clearly the period of their service.

(iii) Internees during the last war who have the requisite educational qualifications are allowed to deduct from their ages the period spent in internment, if necessary, for the prescribed age limit, provided satisfactory evidence of internment can be produced.

Note.—Marriage will not be a disqualification in the case of applicants under categories (ii) and (iii) above.

If the name/names appearing in the birth certificate differs/differ from the name/names which the applicant ordinarily uses and under which the applicant enters in the application, action should be taken immediately in terms of section 27 or 28, as the case may be, of the Births and Deaths Registration Act, No. 17 of 1951, to get the name in the Birth Registration Entry amended. A certificate copy of a birth registration entry effected more than one year after the date of the birth, under section 24 (6) of the Births and Deaths Registration Act, No. 17 of 1951, as amended by section 2 of the Births and Deaths Registration (Amendment) Act, No. 15 of 1953, will be accepted for purposes of making appointments only after consideration of the evidence by which the date of birth was established.

(iv) A certificate of good character (original) from a responsible person must be attached to the application. If the applicant has been educated at a Government or Assisted School, the certificate of good character must be from the Principal of the last Government or Assisted School which he has attended, otherwise it may be from a Justice of Peace, Advocate, Proctor or Notary, Divisional Revenue Officer or a permanent Government Officer in receipt of an annual salary of Rs. 2,400 or over, or generally speaking, some person whose name is known and to whom reference can be readily made. The name, designation and address of the person granting the certificate must be clearly indicated in the certificate. (Candidates who are already in the Public Service will not be required to furnish a certificate under this subsection.)

6. The selected applicants will be required to pass a medical examination, including eyesight test, as to their physical fitness for service in any part of the Island immediately on selection.

7. Applications which do not conform to the conditions laid down herein will be rejected.

8. Conditions of Service. (a) Probation.—On selection apprentices will serve three months in the Ratmalana Workshops on probation and if subsequently indentured, the probationary period will be considered as part of the apprenticeship.

(b) Indenture — On completion of the probationary period and if recommended for further training by the Chief Mechanical Engineer, apprentices will be required to sign an indenture with the General Manager covering a period of five years' apprenticeship.

(c) Programme of Training.—During the first year all apprentices will be given a general training. On completion of this general training they will be given a specialised training which will be drawn up by the Chief Mechanical Engineer in respect of leach individual's case, based on the ability and aptitude of the apprentice and on the probable requirements of the Running Sheds and Ratmalana Workshops. All apprentices will serve for at least three months in the Mechanical Engineering Drawing Office.

(d) Hours of Duty.—Apprentices will be required to work the regulation hours in force.

(e) Technical Classes.—It is compulsory for apprentices in this scheme to attend technical classes when ordered to do so, and during their five years' indenture will be required to attend classes in Mechanical Engineering at the Ceylon Technical College Arrangements will be made to enable apprentices to attend these classes and they will be expected to obtain a pass in the examination held at the end of each year's course. Apprentices failing to pass will not be allowed to take up the course a second time except under special circumstances

(f) Discipline.—Apprentices will be required to conform to the departmental rules and regulations in force. Breach of discipline, misconduct and other offences will be met by such punishment as the General Manager or other officer authorised by him may decide.

(g) Progress.—An apprentice must merit a good certificate from the immediate superior under whom he is working before he can proceed from one stage of his training to another. He will be judged on attendance, punctuality, good disposition and willingness to work, general ability, good conduct and steadiness. An apprentice may be called upon to make up all time lost due to sickness and absence with or without leave, before he takes the next step in his course of training.

Departmental examinations, both written and oral, may be held as and when necessary, and apprentices will be required to obtain a pass in such examinations. Failure to pass a departmental examination will result in the apprentice having to take over again the section of training in which he failed, and the time so lost will be added to his total period of training. At the end of the five years' apprenticeship, apprentices will be required to pass a final examination which will be held by the Mechanical Engineer in the case of the Ratmalana Workshop apprentices and by the Divisional Transportation Superintendent, Colombo, in the case of Running Shed apprentices.

(h) Termination of Indenture.—The General Manager reserves the right to terminate an indenture without previous notice if an apprentice's conduct is not satisfactory, or if an apprentice does not make satisfactory progress in his training or if for any cause he considers the continuance of an apprentice in training not in the interests of the service

Increments will be granted subject to satisfactory progress as provided for in clause (g) above.

(1) Employment after Completion of Apprenticeship—On completion of five years' apprenticeship, apprentices, if suitable, will be retained in service in the Ratmalana Workshops or in the Running Sheds as Minor Supervisors on the salary scale applicable at the time of completion of training.

They will be eligible for promotion, if suitable, to the grade of Foreman, Grade II, as and when vacancies occur. Normally a minimum period of four years' training in the Supervisory Grade will be required before appointment as Foreman, Grade II, but special consideration will be given to those who merit same.

9. The grant of leave and other conditions of service will be governed by the recommendations in Sessional Paper VIII of 1934, as modified by the recommendations in Sessional Paper VIII of 1946 and Sessional Paper XII of 1953, in the case of new entrants to the Public Service.
