RICE (WHOLESALE AND RETAIL)

THE CONTROL OF PRICES ACT, No. 29 OF 1950

Order

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by section 4, read with section 3 (2), of the Control of Prices Act, No. 29 of 1950, I, Manicam Sivanathan, Deputy Controller of Prices (Food), for the Hambantota District, do by this Order—

- (i) revoke with effect from May 14, 1956, the Price Order mentioned below so far as it fixes the maximum prices of rice for the Hambantota District—

Food and Price Order No H20 dated May 25, 1955, published in *Government Gazette* No. 10,803 of June 3, 1955,

- (ii) fix with effect from May 14, 1956, the prices specified in column 2 of the first schedule hereto to be the maximum wholesale price per 80 measures nett above which rice shall not be sold within the respective areas mentioned in the corresponding entries in column 1 of the first schedule hereto,
- (iii) fix with effect from May 14, 1956, the prices specified in column 2 of the second schedule hereto to be the maximum retail price per measure above which rice shall not be sold within the respective areas mentioned in the corresponding entries in column 1 of the second schedule hereto,

- (iv) direct that for the purposes of this Order—

- (a) any sale of any quantity of rice for the purpose of resale shall be deemed to be a sale by wholesale,
- (b) any sale of any quantity of rice for the purpose of consumption or use by the purchaser shall be deemed to be a sale by retail,
- (c) "measure" shall be deemed to be the standard quart, dry measure, and
- (d) the maximum wholesale price which may be demanded for any quantity of rice which is less than or more than 80 measures nett shall be determined by reference to the maximum wholesale price per 80 measures nett fixed by this Order

- (v) direct that no person shall sell rice which is adulterated with any other article,

- (vi) direct that when any rice is sold the maximum prices fixed by this Order shall include the price of the wrapper or container, if any, in which such rice is sold,

- (vii) direct that in every area where maximum prices are fixed by this Order, every trader who has any rice in possession or under his control at any place, shall exhibit conspicuously at that place a notice in which there shall be set out the maximum prices fixed by this Order in that area, and

- (viii) direct that every person who sells rice by retail shall on demand, and every person who sells rice by wholesale shall, give the purchaser

Under section 7 of the same Ordinance, I proclaim that no movement of cattle and cart traffic from and to these villages and other parts of the district shall be allowed until this proclamation is revoked

The attention of all cattle owners and carters in the areas is drawn to the Contagious Disease (Animals) Regulation, 1937, which lays down action which persons are by law, required to take in an "INFECTED AREA" Details of these regulations can be obtained from the Assistant Veterinary Surgeon, Badulla, and the office of the Divisional Revenue Officer, Wellassa
