Hours of Inspection

The office shall be open to the public every week day, except Saturday, between the hours of ten to four, and on Saturdays between the hours of ten to one, except on public holidays. Applications for inspections will however be accepted up to 3 p.m. on week days and 12 noon on Saturdays.

Trade Marks limited to colours

Where it is stated in the advertisement of an application that the mark upon its registration is to be limited to

certain colours, the colours are, as far as possible indicated in the accompanying representation of the mark in the usual heraldic manner.

Association

Where it is stated that an advertised mark is to be associated (under Section 22 of the Trade Marks Ordinance (Cap. 121)), with another mark, it is indicated by its official number.

Applications for registration in Part A of the Register are shown with the official number unaccompanied by any letter. Applications for Part B of the Register are distinguished by the letter B prefixed to the official number.

OPPOSITION

NOTICE is hereby given that any person who has grounds of objection to the registration of the following trade marks may, within two months from the date of this Gazette, lodge Notice of Opposition on form T. M. No. 7 bearing an uncanceled or impressed stamp of Rs. 25. The period of lodging Notice of Opposition may be enlarged by the Registrar if he thinks fit and upon such terms as he may direct.

Formal opposition should not be lodged until after reasonable notice has been given by letter to the Applicant for registration so as to afford him an opportunity of withdrawing his application before the expense of preparing the Notice of Opposition is incurred. Failure to give such notice will be taken into account in considering any application by an Opponent for an Order of Costs if the opposition is uncontested by the Applicant.

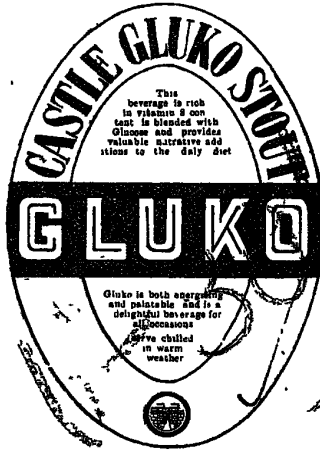

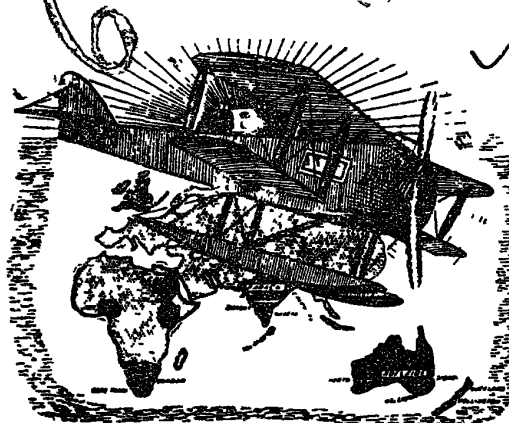

"Concrete armour bar

Abstract—The nature of the invention can be ascertained from the only claim which is as follows —

Concrete armour bar, twisted in the cold state, characterized by the fact that it has a cross-section of a generally circular shape with a slightly undulating periphery having no discontinuities, notches, teeth or other singularities, in order to ensure a good adherence to concrete, whilst sensibly retaining the mechanical resistance properties of the cold twisted bar with a circular cross-section

"Improvements in or relating to steroids and the preparation thereof

Abstract—This invention relates to certain novel steroid compounds. Its nature can be ascertained from claim 1 which reads as follows —

A process for preparing a steroid compound adapted to serve as a hormonally inactive, water-soluble, central nervous system depressant which is an ionic ester of a steroid of the pregnane or allopregnane series having the nucleus of Formula 1, said process comprising converting a non-ionic ester of a steroid to an ionic ester of such steroid and if necessary providing the pregnane or allopregnane nucleus by hydrogenation of a corresponding unsaturating nucleus

There are 40 claims and 28 examples
