The Accounts of the Nawalapitiya Town for the year 1955, as furnished by the Special Commissioner of the Town, have been audited under my direction

- 2. The item of Rs. 149,138, 24 shown as advances on the Assets side includes sums of Rs. 15,957 22, Rs 6,086.49 and Rs 11,434.27 totalling Rs. 33,477 98 which were seized on the order of Court or were paid in satisfaction of decrees of Court in cases instituted against the Council in respect of transactions entered into by a former Chairman and a further sum of Rs 54,300 disallowed in audit and surchaiged on the same Chairman, the recovery of all of which is doubtful.
- 3 Subject to the observations, I am of opinion, that the statement of Assets and Liabilities gives a true and fair view of the state of affairs of the Nawalapitiya Town as at December 31, 1955.
