## Part V—Notice to revoke or suspend Private Carrier's Permits under Regulation 12 of the Motor Traffic (Goods Carriage) Regulations, 1951

IN terms of section 94 (2) of the Motor Traffic Act, No. 14 of 1951, and Regulation 12 of the Motor Traffic (Goods Carriage) Regulations, 1951, I hereby give notice that I propose to revoke or suspend the following Private Carrier's Permit:—

2 Any request from the permit holder that a public enquiry be held or any representation from any other person in relation to the proposed revocation or suspension should be made on or before July 14, 1956

3 Every representation shall be made by a written statement on suitable paper and shall be signed by a person duly making the representation

4 Every statement of representation shall—

(a) be in duplicate, and

(b) set out the specific grounds on which representation is based

5 Every statement of representation shall be enclosed in a sealed envelope and addressed to the Commissioner of Motor Traffic, Branch L, Colombo, and delivered to the Office of the Commissioner or sent by registered post so as to reach him not later than the date specified in the notice. If the representation is delivered at the office, a signed receipt must be obtained.
