BY virtue of the powers vested in me by section 7 (4) (a) (i) of the Food Production (Estates) Act, No. 40 of 1954, I, Don Philip Rupasinghe Gunawardena, Minister of Agriculture and Food, do hereby declare—

(1) the Agricultural Produce Corporation Limited, being an incorporated company which is engaged in the production of foodstuffs in Ceylon, to be a company approved by me for the purposes of the aforesaid section, and

Rules

1. These rules may be cited as the Milk Board (Loans) Rules, 1956.

2. Every loan granted by the Board to any local authority shall be subject to the following conditions:—

(a) the amount of the loan shall not be applied to any purpose other than the purpose for which the loan was granted;

(b) interest shall be payable on the amount of the loan at the rate of four per centum for a year; and

(c) repayment of the loan shall be made in such number of equal monthly instalments not exceeding one hundred and twenty as may be determined by the Board and the payment of the first instalment shall be made in the month immediately following the month in which the loan is granted.

3. Every loan granted by the Board to any body (other than a local authority) or to any person shall be subject to the following conditions :—

(a) the amount of the loan shall not exceed fifty per centum of the total value of the immovable property and livestock possessed by such body or person for the maintenance of milk production and marketing services ;

(b) interest shall be payable on the amount of the loan at the rate of 4 per centum for a year ;

(c) (i) where the loan is granted for the purchase of livestock, the repayment of the loan shall be made in such number of monthly instalments not exceeding thirty as may be determined by the Board and the payment of the first instalment shall be made in the month immediately following the month in which the loan is granted ;

(ii) where the loan is granted for any purpose other than the purchase of livestock, the repayment of the loan shall be made in such number of monthly instalments not exceeding sixty as may be determined by the Board and the payment of the first instalment shall be made in the month immediately following the month in which the loan is granted ;

(d) the Board may recover any sum due to the Board on the loan granted to any body or person from moneys due from the Board to that body or person for milk supplied to the Board ;

(e) where default is made in the payment of any sum due on the loan granted to any body or person or where the Chairman of the Board is satisfied that a body to which the loan has been granted is likely to be dissolved or liquidated, the Chairman of the Board may require that body or person, as the case may be, to pay the whole of the unpaid portion of the loan and the interest due thereon within such time as he may specify ;

(f) the Board may call upon any body to which, or any person to whom, the loan has been granted to satisfy the Board that the loan has been or is being applied to the purpose for which it was granted ; and

(g) the Board may cause the premises used for the maintenance of milk production and marketing services by any body to which, or any person to whom, the loan has been granted, to be inspected by an officer of the Board in order to satisfy itself that the loan has been or is being applied to the purpose for which it was granted

4. In these rules "Board" means the Milk Board established under section 2 of the Milk Board Act, No. 12 of 1954.

STANDARDS ADVISORY COUNCIL

A Standard Advisory Council has been established by a directive of the Minister of Industries and Fisheries and the Council consists of the following:—

- (1) Director of Industries—ex officio, Chairman.
- (2) Director of Public Works—ex officio.
- (3) Director of Agriculture—ex officio.
- (4) Director of Commerce—ex officio.
- (5) Government Analyst—ex officio.
- (6) Director of the Ceylon Institute of Scientific and Industrial Research—ex officio.
- (7) Senator E. W. Kannangara, O.B.E., representative of the L. C. P. A.
- (8) Mr. N. C. Alcock, representative of the Ceylon Association of Manufacturers.
- (9) Mr. T. N. Wynne Jones, representative of the Engineering Association of Ceylon.
- (10) Dr. S. L. de Silva, representative of the Association for the Advancement of Science.
- (11) Professor E. O. E. Pereira, nominated by the Minister.
- (12) Major J. H. Hoare, nominated by the Minister.
- (13) Mr. T. S. Jinadasa, nominated by the Minister.

2. The Council will prepare standards based on the principles that standards will be in accordance with the needs of the particular industry and fulfil a generally

recognized want and that the interest of both the producer and the consumer will be considered. The Advisory Council will set up sub-committees consisting of representatives of producers, manufacturers, users, and interested parties, such as trade associations, scientific organizations and experts. The sub-committees will invite by notifications in the Press and *Government Gazette* representations from the members of the public and other interested parties. These committees will after due consideration recommend to the Advisory Council for ratification the standards which they consider suitable for the particular industry they have examined. Once the recommended standards have been ratified by the Advisory Council they will be published in the form of booklets and circulated to Government Departments, Universities, Technical Institutions, manufacturers, and traders who are registered in the department, and due publicity will be given through all possible means.

3 The Advisory Council have already accepted the recommendation made by the sub-committee on citronella oil. Sub-committees have been set up for the following industries—

- (1) Cinnamon quills and oils.
- (2) Bricks and tiles.
- (3) Matches
- (4) Paints, furniture polish and varnishes.
- (5) Wood preservatives.
- (6) Soap.
- (7) Building timber.
- (8) Sealing wax.

4 Generally the prescribing of standards will encourage local manufacturers to improve the quality of their products up to the standards prescribed as a natural consequence of consumers showing preference for articles which manufacturers claim the attainment of standards prescribed.

5 The standards prescribed by the Council also would give the Government the opportunity for recognising these standards in any legislation, rule or administrative procedure, particularly if there was need—

- (i) to prevent the export of inferior and adulterated goods,
- (ii) to ensure that goods sold under the Industrial Products Act to importers are of the prescribed quality,
- (iii) to prevent the manufacture beyond the limits which make an article (not within the scope of the Food and Drugs Act) dangerous
