THE FOOD CONTROL ACT, No. 25 OF 1950 Order No. 71

BY virtue of the powers vested in me by Section 4 (1) (i) of the Food Control Act, No. 25 of 1950, I, Don Phillip Rupasinghe Gunawardena, Minister of Agriculture and Food, do by this Order—

(1) Prohibit the transport or removal without a permit from the Deputy Food Controller, Jaffna District, of any quantity of red onions or Bellary onions except for 7 lb. taken by any person—

- (a) by boat or sailing vessel from any point of the sea or lagoon coast around Jaffna Peninsula;
- (b) from the Jaffna Peninsula.

"Jaffna Peninsula" for the purpose of this order means the revenue district of Jaffna inclusive of Divisional Revenue Officer's Division of Punakari-Thunukkai, the division of Karachchi in the Divisional Revenue Officer's Division of Pachchilaipallai-Karachchi and the Village Headmen's divisions of Kovilvayal and Mullian in the Pallai Division of the Divisional Revenue Officer's Division of Pachchilaipallai-Karachchi and the Village Headman's division of Thanankilappu in the Divisional Revenue Officer's Division of Thenmaradchy.

(2) Revoke my Orders No. 68 and 70 published in Government Gazette Extraordinary No. 11,120 of May 29, 1957, and Government Gazette Extraordinary No. 11,135 of June 25, 1957, respectively.
