**THE MUSLIM MOSQUES AND CHARITABLE TRUSTS OR WAKFS ACT, No. 51 OF 1956**

REGULATIONS made by the Minister of Home Affairs, with the advice of the Mosques and Muslim Charitable Trusts or Wakfs Board, under section 54 of the Muslim Mosques and Charitable Trusts or Wakfs Act, No. 51 of 1956, and approved by the Senate and the House of Representatives.

**Regulations**

1. These regulations may be cited as the Muslim Mosques and Charitable Trusts or Wakfs Regulations, 1958.
2. In these regulations—
  - “ Act ” means the Muslim Mosques and Charitable Trusts or Wakfs Act, No. 51 of 1956 ;
  - “ Board ” means the Mosques and Muslim Charitable Trusts or Wakfs Board established under the Act ;
  - “ Commissioner ” means the Commissioner for Mosques and Muslim Charitable Trusts, or Wakfs appointed under the Act.
3. (1) A notice under section 11 of the Act shall be sent by the Board by registered post to the address given by the applicant in his application for registration of the mosque, shrine or place of religious resort, or to the last known place of abode of such applicant.
- (2) The fee payable by any person for the inspection of the Register of Mosques shall be fifty cents.
4. The particulars required to be entered in the Register of Mosques in respect of every mosque, Muslim shrine or place of religious resort shall be as follows :—
  - (a) The name and situation of the mosque, shrine or place of religious resort ;
  - (b) The name or names of the trustee or trustees of the mosque, shrine or place of religious resort, and their respective addresses ;
  - (c) The approximate number of persons in the Jama'ath ;
  - (d) The particulars of any trust instrument relating to the mosque, shrine or place of religious resort ;
  - (e) The particulars of any movable or immovable property belonging to, appropriated for the use of, or held in trust by any person exclusively for the benefit of, the mosque, shrine or place of religious resort ;
  - (f) The particulars of the rents, income and profits from such property ;
  - (g) The particulars of any educational institutions maintained in connection with the mosque, shrine or place of religious resort ;
  - (h) The particulars relating to the expenditure of the income of the mosque, shrine or place of religious resort ;
  - (i) The orders of the Board relating to any mosque, shrine or place of religious resort.
5. The accounts to be prepared under section 27 of the Act shall be in the form set out in the Schedule A hereto
6. The statement required to be furnished under section 33 of the Act shall contain the following particulars in addition to the particulars required to be furnished under section 34 of the Act :—
  - (a) The terms and conditions of any lease, charge or encumbrance in respect of the properties subject to the trust or wakf ;
  - (b) The particulars relating to any sale or alienation prior to May 1, 1957, of any property subject to the trust or wakf ;
  - (c) The name and address of the bank in which, and the name and address of the person in whose name, the income from the properties subject to the trust or wakf is deposited ;
  - (d) The name and address of the person responsible for keeping and maintaining the accounts relating to the properties subject to the trust or wakf, and the name and address of the auditor who has been auditing those accounts.
7. The accounts required to be furnished under section 35 of the Act shall be in the form set out in Schedule B hereto.
8. (1) The amount of any contribution payable to the Commissioner under sub-section (2) of section 43 of the Act may, in case of default of payment, be recovered as though it were a fine imposed under the Act, on application made in that behalf to the Magistrate having jurisdiction in the area within which the person or persons liable to pay such contribution is or are for the time being resident.
- (2) Every application under paragraph (1) shall be made by the Commissioner, and shall be supported by a certificate under his hand stating the amount of the contribution payable, and the name or names of the person or persons liable to pay such contribution.
- (3) Every amount referred to in paragraph (1) may be recovered as a fine notwithstanding that the amount exceeds the amount of the maximum fine which the Magistrate may in his ordinary jurisdiction impose, and when recovered shall be remitted to the Commissioner.
9. (1) The Commissioner shall deposit the moneys in the Muslim Charities Fund in a current account in a bank or banks approved by the Board.
- (2) Such account shall be opened in the name of the Muslim Charities Fund and shall be operated by the Commissioner on the directions of the Board.
10. The Board may invest the moneys in the Muslim Charities Fund in—
  - (a) the purchase or lease of any immovable property ; or
  - (b) the purchase of any shares in a limited-liability company registered under the Companies Ordinance, No. 51 of 1938.
11. (1) Every member of the Board, other than the Commissioner, shall be entitled, in respect of his attendance at meetings of the Board to an allowance of Rs. 25 for each day or part thereof on which he attends a meeting of the Board.
- (2) Every member of the Board, other than the Commissioner, shall be entitled, in respect of the travelling done by him from his residence to the place of meeting of the Board to a travelling allowance calculated at the rate of forty cents for each mile or part thereof :

Provided, however, that if the distance from his residence to the place of meeting of the Board exceeds 30 miles, and if there is a train service between his place of residence and the place of the meeting of the Board, he shall not be entitled to a travelling allowance unless he travels by train, and the travelling allowance payable to him shall be equivalent to the first class train fare for the journey.

12. The Administrative Assistant of the Department of Mosques and Muslim Charitable Trusts or any other officer of that Department nominated by the Commissioner for the purpose shall function as the Secretary to the Board. The Secretary shall keep a record of the proceedings of every meeting of the Board.

### REFERENCE UNDER THE FISHERIES ORDINANCE

January 10, 1959.

SIR,—In terms of section 18A (1) of the Fisheries Ordinance, No. 24 of 1940, as amended by the Fisheries (Amendment) Acts, Nos. 25 and 30 of 1952 and 1956 respectively, I refer to you a dispute that has arisen between the rod and line fishermen and Barudel Fishermen of Hikkaduwa with regard to their respective fishing rights in the bays known as—(1) Mavakadawala; (2) Galkadanawala; (3) Paruwendawala; (4) Kudovakadawala and (5) Moderawala at Hikkaduwa, for public enquiry and report.

2. The subject matter of the dispute is as follows:—

The rod and line fishermen complain that the use of barudels in these bays disturb the fish and scare them away. The Barudel fishermen on the other hand contend that the Regulations made under the Game Protection Ordinance of 1909 and published in the *Ceylon Government Gazette* No. 7,866 of July 3, 1931 should be revised permitting the use of barudel at times when its use is, in the opinion of the fishermen, advisable.

Since all matters in dispute may not have been specified in the representations already made, I request you to inquire into any matters incidental or related to the dispute as outlined above and to make your report on all such matters.
