The Award

This is an award under section 17 of the Industrial Disputes Act, No. 43 of 1950, as amended by the Industrial Disputes (Amendment) Acts, No. 25 of 1956, No. 14 of 1957 and No. 62 of 1957. It relates to a dispute between the Nidahas Karmika Saha Velanda Sevaka Vurthiya Samithiya (hereinafter referred to as the "Union") and the Equipment and Construction Company Limited (hereinafter referred to as the "Company").

2. By Order under section 3 (1) (d) of the aforesaid Act, the Acting Deputy Commissioner of Labour, referred the dispute to me for settlement by arbitration. According to the statement of the Acting Deputy Commissioner of Labour appended to the Order under section 3 (1) (d) of the aforesaid Act, dated 10th February, 1959, the matters in dispute between the aforesaid parties are—

- (1) The demand for the payment of the special living allowance of Rs. 17/50 per mensem from 1st January, 1958; and
- (2) The demand for a meal allowance of 60 cents per diem with effect from 13th January, 1959.

3. The Company is a firm of bridge builders. The two demands referred to in paragraph 2 above were made on behalf of about 58 workers employed at the Nanu Oya bridge site. The bridge is being constructed on the Gampola road and the site is between $\frac{1}{2}$ and $\frac{1}{4}$ mile from the Peradeniya junction. The Company tendered for this project in September, 1956, and the whole job is to be completed by April, 1959.

4. On the second date of hearing, viz., 26th February, 1959, the Union withdrew both the demands set out in the statement of the Acting Deputy Commissioner of Labour, dated 10th February, 1959, appended to his Order under section 3 (1) (d) of the Industrial Disputes Act, dated 10th February, 1959, referring the dispute to me for settlement by arbitration. These demands are therefore rejected.

5. The parties reached agreement in respect of the following matters:—

- (1) The Union and the Company have reached an agreement in regard to the payment of an ex gratia retrenchment gratuity when the work on the bridge site on Nanu Oya in Peradeniya comes to an end which is expected to take place shortly.
- (2) It is agreed between the Union and the Company that when the services of the workers are terminated, the Company will pay to each worker two weeks' gross wages for each year of service or employment.
- (3) It is also agreed by the Company that it will not recover from the workers the ex gratia payment of Rs. 15 which was made to each of the workers by the Company after the Company and the Union had signed the agreement dated 30th January, 1959.
- (4) The Union agrees that there will be no further or other claims or demands of whatever kind or nature from or on behalf of the workers with regard to any matter or matters which were under negotiation or dispute or which

could have been under negotiation or dispute between the Union and the Company prior to the date of reference of this dispute for arbitration.

- (5) The Union also undertakes to see that the workers will not "go slow" but will co-operate with the management in bringing the bridge work to a completion.

The agreement is fair and equitable. I make award accordingly.

THE AWARD

This is an award under section 24 (1) of the Industrial Disputes Act, No. 43 of 1950. The parties to the dispute are the All Ceylon Shop and Hotel Workers' Union of 108, Kew Road, Colombo 2 (hereinafter referred to as "the Union") and Free China Hotel of York House, 106, York Street, Colombo 1, (hereinafter referred to as "the Hotel").

2. The Honourable the Minister of Labour, Housing and Social Services, by his Order under section 4(2) of the said Act dated 24th December, 1958, referred this industrial dispute between the aforesaid parties to this Court for settlement. According to the statement of the Acting Deputy Commissioner of Labour dated 23rd December, 1958, which accompanied the Honourable Minister's Order the "matters in dispute" between the parties are the following demands made by the Union on the Hotel:—

1. An increase of 50 per cent in the present scale of wages with the proviso that no employee should be paid less than Rs. 45 per month. This to have effect from January, 1958.
2. Annual incremental scale.
3. The payment of a special living allowance of Rs. 17.50 and
4. Provision of a morning meal to all workers.

3. Inquiry into this dispute commenced on 3rd February and was continued on 27th February, 1959.

After the case for the Union was closed by Mr. Advocate V. Karalasingham and while the Manager of the Hotel was being examined by Mr. Advocate N. Samarakoon, the parties arrived at a settlement.

4. It would appear that towards the end of 1958, there had been a conference between the parties under the auspices of the Labour Department. At this conference it had been agreed that all the employees of the Hotel should be paid a special living allowance of Rs. 5 per month with effect from December, 1958.

5. The settlement arrived at between the parties is—

- (1) that all the employees of the Hotel drawing a monthly salary of Rs. 50 and under should be given an increase of Rs. 5 per month;
- (2) that all the employees of the Hotel drawing a monthly salary of over Rs. 50 should be given an increase of Rs. 2.50 per month;
- (3) that these increases are to be in addition to the Rs. 5 that is being paid per month as a special living allowance from December 1, 1958;
- (4) that the Hotel should continue to give overtime work beyond the 8-hour limit per day and pay overtime as before subject, however, to the Hotel in its discretion discontinuing overtime work;
- (5) that the increments referred to in clauses (1) and (2) above are to be effective from 1st February, 1959;
- (6) that the Union withdraws demands Nos. 2, 3 and 4 referred to in paragraph 2 above.

6. We have had the advantage of hearing the case for the Union fully and have also seen the audited balance sheets of the Hotel. After mature consideration we are of the view that the settlement arrived at is just and equitable and we make award in terms of the above settlement as regards demand No. 1. Demands Nos. 2, 3, and 4 are rejected.

7. This award will take effect from 1st February, 1959.
