THE POST OFFICE ORDINANCE

IN the exercise of the powers vested in the Minister of Posts, Broadcasting and Information by section 9 (3) of the Post Office Ordinance (Chapter 146), as modified by the Proclamation published in Gazette Extraordinary No. 9,773 of September 24, 1947, and delegated to the Postmaster-General by notification made under section 91 of that Ordinance, and published in Gazette No. 8,099 of January 11, 1985, and continuing in force by virtue of paragraph (6) of the said Proclamation, I, Herbert Ehelapola Seneviratne, Postmaster-General, do hereby notify that the terms,

conditions and requirements relating to the foreign parcel post shall, on and after April 1, 1959, have effect with the amendments set out hereinunder.

The terms, conditions and requirements relating to the foreign parcel post, published as the Foreign Parcel Post Rules, 1934, in Gazette No. 8,071 of August 3, 1934, as last amended by the terms, conditions and requirements published in *Gazette* No. 10,166 of October 20, 1950, are hereby further amended as follows.

- (1) in rule 5, by the substitution, for the words "a Customs declaration, in such form" of the words "a Despatch note in duplicate and Customs Declarations in such forms '
- (2) in rule 7—(a) by the substitution, for the figure "5", of the figures "75"; and (b) by the substitution, for the figures "20", of the figures "75";
- (3) in rule 25, in paragraph 1 thereof, by the subs-titution, for the words "Customs declaration form", of the words "Despatch notes and Customs declaration forms '
- (4) in rule 26, by the substitution, for the figures and word "25 cents" relating to Customs Clearance Fee, of the figure and word "1 rupee";
- (5) in rule 27, in paragraph (1) thereof, by the subs-titution, for the words "Customs declaration form", of the words "Despatch notes and Customs declaration forms '
- (6) in rule 29, by the substitution, for the figures and word "25 cents", relating to Customs Clearance Fee, of the figure and word "1 rupee";
- (7) in the heading immediately after rule 29, by the substitution, for the words "Redirected parcels" of the words "Redirected and undelivered parcels";
- (8) in rule 30, in paragraph ii (b) thereof,-
 - (a) by the substitution, for the word and figures "Re. 1.65", of the word and figures "Rs. 2.17"; and
 - (b) by the substitution, for the word and figures " Re. 1.72 ", of the word and figures " Rs. 2.27 ";
- (9) by the omission, immediately after rule 30, of the heading "Delivery to Second the heading Addressee ";
- (10) by the substitution, for rule 31, of the following new rule:---
 - " 31. (1) The sender of a parcel may request, at the time of posting, that if the parcel cannot be delivered as addressed, it should be-
 - (a) returned forthwith to the sender;
 - (b) returned to the sender at the end of a given period;
 - (c) delivered $_{\mathrm{to}}$ an alternative addressee;
 - (d) redirected with a view to be delivered to the original addressee; or
 - (e) treated as abandoned.
 - (2) Every sender desiring to avail himself of this facility, shall indicate by underlining the appropriate direction on the

- back of the Despatch notes, and shall reproduce the direction underlined on the parcel itself.";
- (11) in rule 33, by the substitution, for the words "by land or sea", of the words "by land, sea or air ";
- (12) in rule 35, in paragraph (1) thereof, by the substitution for the words "bullion or jewellery", of the words "bullion, jewellery, Bank notes or securities of any kind payable to bearer.";
- (13) in rule 36, by the substitution, for paragraph (i) and Schedule thereof, of the following new paragraph:—
 - "(i) On every parcel that is to be insured, an insurance fee shall, in addition to the postage, be charged at the rate of 75 cents for every 300 rupees, or fraction of 300 rupees of the insured value.";
- (14) in rule 38, by the substitution, for the words "Customs declaration", of the words "Despatch notes, Customs declarations";
- (15) by the substitution, for rule 40, of the following new rule:
 - "40. (1) Subject to paragraph (6) of this rule, the sender of an insured parcel shall be entitled to compensation corresponding to the actual amount of the loss, theft or damage: Provided that the compensation payable shall not in any case exceed the insured value.
 - (2) Indirect loss, or loss of profits, shall not be taken into consideration in computing the amount of compensation.
 - (3) In the case of loss or total theft of a parcel or total damage to a parcel, or in the case of refusal by the addressee to take delivery thereof because of the bad condition of a parcel, where such condition is attributable to the negligence of the officers of the Post Office the sender shall be entitled, in addition to compensation, to a refund of the postal charges paid, but the insurance fee shall not be refunded.
 - (4) Compensation shall be calculated on the current price, converted into gold francs, of goods of the same kind, at the place and time at which the parcel was accepted. Where it is not possible to find out such current price, compensation shall be calculated on the ordinary value of the articles assessed on the same basis.
 - (5) Compensation shall be paid to the addressee either where he took delivery of a parcel that had been tampered with or damaged subject to his right to claim compensation, or where he proves that the sender had waived his rights in favour of the addressee.
 - (6) No compensation shall be payable in any of the following cases:---
 - (a) Where the loss or damage, has been caused by the fault or negligence of the sender, or has arisen from the nature of the article;

- (b) Where the parcel has been fraudulently insured for a sum in excess of the real value of the contents, or where there has been any other fraud on the part of the sender or the addressee;
- (c) Where the insured article has been duly delivered and accepted without any reservation;
- (d) Where the sender or addressee has not given intimation of the loss or damage within twelve months from the day after that on which the parcel was posted;
- (e) When the loss or damage was due to improper or insecure packing;
- (f) Where there has been no visible damage to the cover or seals;
- (g) Where the loss or damage has been due to causes beyond human control;
- (h) Where articles cannot be accounted for owing to the destruction of official records through a cause beyond human control, provided that proof of responsibility of the Post Office has not been otherwise established;
- (i) Where the insured article contained anything the transmission of which is prohibited by the foreign parcel post: Provided that compensation shall not be inadmissible by reason only of the fact that the insured parcel contained any correspondence;
- (j) Where the article is seized under the inland legislation of the country of destination;
- (k) Where the parcel is addressed to a prisoner of war or internee.";
- (16) in rule 42—
 - (a) by the substitution, for the word
 "jewellery", of the words "jewellery or Bank notes or currency notes or securities of any kind payable to bearer";
 - (b) by the substitution, for the word "objects", of the word "articles";
- (17) in rule 43—
 - (a) in paragraph (i) thereof by the omission of the words " (not in consequence of any legal liability, but voluntarily as an act of grace) ";
 - (b) by the substitution, for paragraphs (iii), (iv), (v) and (vi) thereof, of the following new paragraphs:—
 - "(iii) Indirect loss or loss of profits shall not be taken into consideration in computing the amount of compensation.
 - (iv) No compensation shall be payable on any of the following cases:----
 - (a) When the loss, theft or damage is attributable to causes beyond human control;

- (b) Where parcels cannot be accounted for owing to the destruction of official records through a cause beyond human control, provided that proof of responsibility of the Post Office has not been otherwise established;
- (c) When the damage has been caused by the fault or negligence of the sender or has arisen from the nature of the contents as in a case where a parcel contains any liquid or semi-liquid or any article which is composed, wholly or in part, of an exceptionally fragile or brittle material, or which from its nature or construction is peculiarly liable to damage, however carefully it may be packed;
- (d) Where the parcel contains anything not legally transmissible by post or where the parcel has not been packed or posted in the manner prescribed;
- (c) When the sender has made no enquiry within a period of 12 months from the day after that on which the parcel was posted;
- (f) Where the parcel has been seized under the internal legislation of the country of destination;
- (g) Where the parcel is addressed to a prisoner of war or internee;
- (h) Where the parcel has been delivered to the addressee and no complaint has been made at the time of delivery.
- (v) In the case of loss or total theft of a parcel or total damage to a parcel or in the case of refusal by the addressee to take delivery thereof owing to the bad condition of a parcel, where such condition is attributable to the negligence of the officers of the postal service, the sender shall be entitled in addition to compensation, to a refund of the postal charges.
- (vi) Compensation shall be paid to the addresse either where he took delivery of a parcel that has been tampered with or damaged, subject to his right to claim compensation, or where he proves that the sender had waived his rights in favour of the addressee.
- (vi) (a) Where the loss or total theft of a parcel or total damage to a parcel arises from such circumstances beyond human control as do not give rise to indemnification, the sender shall be entitled to the rèpayment not only of the land sea and air rates

appropriate to any sector not traversed by the parcel, but also of the charges, whatever their nature, relating to a service paid for in advance but not rendered.";

- (c) by the substitution, in paragraph (ix) thereof, for the words "endeavour to obtain compensation for the sender", of the words "pay compensation to the sender."; and
- (18) in rule 44, in paragraph (1) thereof, by the substitution, for the words "within a reasonable time", of the words "as soon as possible".

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NOTIFICATION UNDER SECTION 18A ,) OF THE FISHERIES ORDINANCE, No. 24 OF 1940, AS AMENDED BY THE FISHERIES (AMEND-MENT) ACTS Nos. 25 OF 1952 AND 30 OF 1956

. 1. J

IN terms of section 18A (1) of the Fisheries Ordinance No. 24 of 1940, as amended by the Fisheries (Amendment) Acts Nos. 25 of 1952 and 30 of 1956, the Honourable P. H. William de Silva, Minister of Industries and Fisheries, has referred to me a dispute that has arisen between the rod and line fishermen and Barudel fishermen of Hikkaduwa with regard to their respective fishing rights in the bays known as (1) Mavakadawala, (2) Galkadanawala, (3) Paruwebendawala, (4) Kudovakadawala and (5) Moderawala, at Hikkaduwa for public enquiry and report.

2. The subject matter of the dispute is as follows:

The rod and line fishermen complain that the use of barudels in these bays disturb the fish and scare them away. The barudel fishermen on the other hand contend that the Regulations made under the Game Protection Ordinance of 1909 and published in the Ceylon Government Gazette No. 7,866 of July 3, 1931, should be revised permitting the use of barudel at times when its use is, in the opinion of the fishermen, advisable.

3. Since all matters in dispute may not have been specified in the representations already made, I have been requested to inquire into any matters incidental or related to the dispute as outlined above and to make my report on all such matters.

4. I invite all persons concerned or interested in the dispute, who desire so to do, to make written representations relating to this dispute to the Director of Fisheries, to reach his office at Galle Face, Colombo, on or before 27th April, 1959.

5. I shall commence a public enquiry into the subject matter of the dispute at the G/Hikkaduwa Central School, Hikkaduwa at 10 a.m. on 30th May, 1959, and will hear evidence whether oral or documentary upon oath between the hours 10 a.m. 12.30 p.m. and between 2-4 p.m. on 30th and 31st May, 1959, and on any other date to which the enquiry may be adjourned. At the public inquiry I may inspect any place or places in the aforesaid bays and any rod, line, net or other device used for the purpose of fishing in the said bays. All persons entitled to be present and to tender evidence in support of their representations may appear either in person or by counsel or other friend or pleader.
